10 An Act relating to the Council on Law Enforcement
11 Education and Training; making appropriations;
12 stating purposes; requiring budgeting in certain
13 categories and amounts; providing for the duties and
14 compensation of employees; limiting salary of the
15 Director; providing budgetary limitations; providing
16 exceptions to the budgetary limitations; requiring
17 certain budget practices; prohibiting certain budget
18 practices; providing lapse dates; providing an
19 effective date; and declaring an emergency.

22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

23 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Council on Law
24 Enforcement Education and Training from any monies not otherwise
appropriated from the CLEET Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30,
2010, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or so much
thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the
Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training by law.

1 SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated to the Council on Law
2 Enforcement Education and Training from any monies not otherwise
3 appropriated from the CLEET Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30,
4 2008, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or so much
5 thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the
6 Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training by law.

7 SECTION 3. There is hereby appropriated to the Council on Law
8 Enforcement Education and Training from any monies not otherwise
9 appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for
10 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the sum of Three Hundred Fifty
11 Thousand Dollars (\$350,000.00) or so much thereof as may be
12 necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Council on Law
13 Enforcement Education and Training by law.

14 SECTION 4. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the
15 Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training shall budget all
16 funds in the following categories and amounts:

22 SECTION 5. The duties and compensation of employees, not
23 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
24 upon the Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training by law

1 shall be set by the Director. The salary of the Director shall not
2 exceed _____ Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly
3 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010. The Council on Law
4 Enforcement Education and Training for the fiscal year ending June
5 30, 2010, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on
6 full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures excluding
7 expenditures for capital and special projects, except as may be
8 authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of
9 the Oklahoma Statutes:

13 SECTION 6. Appropriations made by this act, not including
14 appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for
15 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010 (hereafter FY-10) or may be
16 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011 (hereafter FY-11).
17 Funds budgeted for FY-10 may be encumbered only through June 30,
18 2010, and must be expended by November 15, 2010. Any funds
19 remaining after November 15, 2010, and not budgeted for FY-11, shall
20 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal
21 year. Funds budgeted for FY-11 may be encumbered only through June
22 30, 2011. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2011, shall lapse
23 to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.
24 These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years

1 simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-10, and not required to pay
2 obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-11, after
3 the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared
4 and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds
5 from the FY-10 budget work program and after such revision has been
6 approved by the Office of State Finance.

7 SECTION 7. This act shall become effective July 1, 2009.

8 SECTION 8. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
9 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
10 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
11 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
