6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to Oklahoma historical societies;
8 charging the Oklahoma Historical Society with the
9 duty of marking the gravesites of deceased Oklahoma
10 Governors; requiring gravesite markers to readily
11 identify the gravesite; authorizing the Oklahoma
12 Historical Society to hold property; granting the
13 Oklahoma Historical Society certain authority;
14 providing for codification; and providing an
15 effective date.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
18 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 6.1 of Title 53, unless there is
19 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

20 A. The Oklahoma Historical Society shall be charged with the
21 duty of marking the gravesites of deceased Governors of the State of
22 Oklahoma which are located in Oklahoma with historical markers that
23 readily identify the gravesite.

24 B. The Oklahoma Historical Society may purchase and hold
property as may be necessary to erect the historical gravesite
markers.

1 C. The Oklahoma Historical Society shall have authority to:

- 2 1. Designate the approximate location of the historical
- 3 gravesite markers;
- 4 2. Preserve the historical gravesite markers;
- 5 3. Design the historical gravesite markers;
- 6 4. Accept gifts and donations for the erection and preservation
- 7 of the gravesite markers; and
- 8 5. Encourage local participation in and contribution to the
- 9 erection and preservation of the gravesite markers through the use
- 10 of gifts, donations, and matching-fund agreements.

11 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2009.
