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6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to schools; amending 70 O.S. 2001,
8 Section 5-130, which relates to use of school
9 buildings and property for other purposes;
10 authorizing a school district to lease property to
11 certain individuals for residential purposes;
12 requiring payment of reasonable consideration for the
13 lease; specifying regulations and conditions relating
14 to insurance; and declaring an emergency.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 70 O.S. 2001, Section 5-130, is
17 amended to read as follows:

18 Section 5-130. A. The board of education of any school
19 district may, under ~~such~~ any regulations and conditions as it may
20 prescribe:

21 1. Open any school building and permit the use of any property
22 belonging to ~~such~~ the district for religious, political, literary,
23 community, cultural, scientific, mechanical, agricultural, or
24 parental involvement purposes, and other purposes of general public
interest including the provision of public library services pursuant

1 to agreements with governing boards or commissions of public
2 libraries or library systems;

3 2. Contract to provide transportation equipment as defined in
4 Section 9-104 of this title for any purpose specified in paragraph 1
5 of this subsection; and

6 3. Make a reasonable charge to cover the cost of the use of
7 ~~such~~ the building, property or transportation equipment.

8 B. The State Board of Education shall encourage each board of
9 education to inquire into and promote the use of its school
10 buildings and property for the purposes provided in subsection A of
11 this section ~~for such activities~~ both before and after regular
12 school hours.

13 C. The board of education of any school district may, under any
14 regulation and conditions as may be prescribed by the board, lease
15 real and personal property owned by the school district to an
16 individual who is not an employee of the school district to be used
17 as residential property by the individual. The individual leasing
18 the property shall be required to pay reasonable consideration for
19 the term of the lease. The regulations and conditions adopted by
20 the board of education shall address the provision of insurance on
21 property.

22 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
23 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
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1 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
2 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
