6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to crimes and punishments; amending
8 21 O.S. 2001, Section 1289.6, which relates to the
9 Oklahoma Firearms Act of 1971; adding condition that
allows firearms to be carried in certain manner;
updating language; and providing an effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2001, Section 1289.6, is
14 amended to read as follows:

15 Section 1289.6

16 CONDITIONS UNDER WHICH FIREARMS MAY BE CARRIED

17 A. A person shall be permitted to carry loaded and unloaded
18 shotguns, rifles and pistols, open and not concealed and without a
19 handgun license as authorized by the Oklahoma Self-Defense Act,
20 ~~Sections 1 through 25 of this act,~~ pursuant to the following
21 conditions:

22 1. When hunting animals or fowl;

1 2. During competition in or practicing in a safety or hunter
2 safety class, target shooting, skeet, trap or other recognized
3 sporting events;

4 3. During participation in or in preparation for a military
5 function of the state military forces to be defined as the Oklahoma
6 Army or Air National Guard, Federal Military Reserve and active
7 military forces;

8 4. During participation in or in preparation for a recognized
9 police function of either a municipal, county or state government as
10 functioning police officials;

11 5. During a practice for or a performance for entertainment
12 purposes; ~~or~~

13 6. When carried in a belt holster that is wholly or partially
14 visible, or carried in a scabbard or case designed for carrying
15 firearms that is wholly or partially visible; or

16 7. For any legitimate purpose not in violation of the Oklahoma
17 Firearms Act of 1971, ~~Sections 1289.1 through 1289.17 of this title~~
18 or any legislative enactment regarding the use, ownership and
19 control of firearms.

20 B. A person shall be permitted to carry unloaded shotguns,
21 rifles and pistols, open and not concealed and without a handgun
22 license as authorized by the Oklahoma Self-Defense Act pursuant to
23 the following conditions:

1 1. When going to or from the ~~person's~~ private residence or
2 vehicle of the person or a vehicle in which the person is riding as
3 a passenger to a place designated or authorized for firearms repairs
4 or reconditioning, or for firearms trade, sale, or barter, or
5 gunsmith, or hunting animals or fowl, or hunter safety course, or
6 target shooting, or skeet or trap shooting or any recognized
7 firearms activity or event and while in such places; or

8 2. For any legitimate purpose not in violation of the Oklahoma
9 Firearms Act of 1971, ~~Sections 1289.1 through 1289.17 of this title.~~

10 C. The provisions of this section shall not be construed to
11 prohibit educational or recreational activities, exhibitions,
12 displays or shows involving the use or display of rifles, shotguns
13 or pistols or other weapons if the activity is approved by the
14 property owner and sponsor of the activity.

15 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2009.
