6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to crimes and punishments; making
8 certain acts unlawful; providing penalties; defining
9 term; providing for codification; and providing an
10 effective date.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1740.1 of Title 21, unless there
14 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 A. It shall be unlawful for any person to enter upon any
16 premises with intent to steal or remove without the consent of the
17 owner, or with intent to aid or assist in stealing or removing any
18 dimensional stone product. Any person violating the provisions of
19 this section shall, upon conviction, be guilty of a felony
20 punishable by imprisonment in the custody of the Department of
21 Corrections for not less than one (1) year, or by a fine of not less
22 than One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), or by both such fine and
23 imprisonment.

1 B. As used in this section, "dimensional stone product" means
2 any natural rock material quarried for the purpose of obtaining
3 blocks or slabs that meet specifications as to size and shape.
4 Varieties of dimensional stone shall include, but not be limited to,
5 granite, limestone, marble, sandstone or slate.

6 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2009.
