6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to higher education; stating
8 legislative intent that the Oklahoma State Regents
9 for Higher Education adopt a policy on residency for
dependents of certain federal government employees;
providing for noncodification; and declaring an
emergency.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
14 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

15 It is the intent of the Legislature that the Oklahoma State
16 Regents for Higher Education review its state residency policies for
17 tuition and fees, scholarship, and financial aid purposes and adopt
18 a policy that allows the dependents of employees of the federal
19 government who were residents of the state and are transferred out-
20 of-state to be charged resident tuition and have the opportunity to
21 participate in all state scholarship and financial aid programs as
22 residents.

23 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
24 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
--

1 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
2 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
