6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to the Ethics Commission; making an
8 appropriation; stating purpose; requiring budgeting
9 in certain categories and amounts; providing for
10 duties and compensation of employees; providing
11 budgetary limitations; providing lapse dates;
12 requiring certain budget procedures; providing an
13 effective date; and declaring an emergency.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Ethics
16 Commission from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the
17 General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year
18 ending June 30, 2010, the sum of Nine Hundred Four Thousand Nine
19 Hundred Sixty Dollars (\$904,960.00) or so much thereof as may be
20 necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Ethics Commission
21 by law.

22 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the Ethics
23 Commission shall budget all funds in the following categories and
24 amounts:

6 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not
7 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
8 upon the Ethics Commission by law shall be set by the Executive
9 Director. The Ethics Commission for the fiscal year ending June 30,
10 2010, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on
11 full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures excluding
12 expenditures for capital and special projects, except as may be
13 authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of
14 the Oklahoma Statutes:

18 SECTION 4. Appropriations made by this act, not including
19 appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for
20 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010 (hereafter FY-10) or may be
21 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011 (hereafter FY-11).
22 Funds budgeted for FY-10 may be encumbered only through June 30,
23 2010, and must be expended by November 15, 2010. Any funds
24 remaining after November 15, 2010, and not budgeted for FY-11, shall

1 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal
2 year. Funds budgeted for FY-11 may be encumbered only through June
3 30, 2011. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2011, shall lapse
4 to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.
5 These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years
6 simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-10, and not required to pay
7 obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-11, after
8 the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared
9 and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds
10 from the FY-10 budget work program and after such revision has been
11 approved by the Office of State Finance.

12 SECTION 5. This act shall become effective July 1, 2009.

13 SECTION 6. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
14 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
15 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
16 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
