HOUSE BILL 1541

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to schools; amending Section 1, Chapter 503, O.S.L. 2004, as last amended by Section 1, Chapter 212, O.S.L. 2007 (70 O.S. Supp. 2008, Section 18-114.12), which relates to the teacher minimum salary schedule; increasing the minimum salary schedule; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 1, Chapter 503, O.S.L. 2004, as last amended by Section 1, Chapter 212, O.S.L. 2007 (70 O.S. Supp. 2008, Section 18-114.12), is amended to read as follows:

Section 18-114.12 A. For the 2005-06 school year, teachers in the public schools of Oklahoma shall receive in salary and/or fringe benefits not less than the amounts specified in the following schedule:

4 E. When determining the Minimum Salary Schedule, "fringe
5 benefits" shall mean all or part of retirement benefits, excluding
6 the contributions made pursuant to subsection A of Section 17-108.1
7 of this title and the flexible benefit allowance pursuant to Section
8 26-105 of this title from the flexible benefit allowance funds
9 disbursed by the State Board of Education and the State Board of
10 Career and Technology Education pursuant to Section 26-104 of this
11 title. Any of the degrees referred to in this section shall be from
12 a college recognized by the State Board of Education. The State
13 Board of Education shall accept teaching experience from out-of-
14 state school districts that are accredited by the State Board of
15 Education or appropriate state accrediting agency for the districts.
16 For the purpose of state salary increments and retirement, no
17 teacher shall be granted credit for more than five (5) years' active
18 duty in the military service, or out-of-state teaching experience as
19 a certified teacher or its equivalent. Nothing in this section
20 shall prohibit boards of education from crediting more years of
21 experience on district salary schedules than those allowed for state
22 purposes. The State Board of Education shall recognize, for
23 purposes of certification and salary increments, the years of
24 experience of a certified teacher who teaches in the Department of

1 Corrections' educational program beginning with fiscal year 1981.
2 The State Board of Education shall recognize for purposes of
3 certification and salary increments the years of experience of a
4 Vocational Rehabilitation Counselor under the Department of Human
5 Services if the counselor was employed as a certified teacher by the
6 State Department of Education when the Division of Vocational
7 Rehabilitation was transferred from the State Board of Career and
8 Technology Education or the State Board of Education to the Oklahoma
9 Public Welfare Commission on July 1, 1968.

10 ~~E.~~ F. The State Board of Education shall recognize for purposes
11 of certification and salary increments all of the years of
12 experience a:

13 1. Vocational Rehabilitation Counselor completed while employed
14 by the Department of Human Services if such counselor was certified
15 as a teacher or was eligible for certification as a teacher in
16 Oklahoma;

17 2. Certified teacher completed while employed by the Department
18 of Human Services Child Study Center at University Hospital, if the
19 teacher was certified as a teacher in Oklahoma; and

20 3. Certified school psychologist or psychometrist completed
21 while employed as a doctoral intern, psychological assistant, or
22 psychologist with any agency of the State of Oklahoma if the
23 experience primarily involved work with persons of school or
24 preschool age and if the person was, at the time the experience was

1 acquired, certified as, or eligible for certification as, a school
2 psychologist or psychometrist.

3 F. G. The provisions of this section shall not apply to
4 teachers who have entered into postretirement employment with a
5 public school in Oklahoma and are still receiving a monthly
6 retirement benefit.

7 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2009.

8 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
9 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
10 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
11 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
