6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to schools; amending Section 1,
8 Chapter 472, O.S.L. 2005 (70 O.S. Supp. 2008, Section
9 5-190), which relates to training for school district
10 treasurers and encumbrance clerks; deleting obsolete
11 language; adding certain school district employees to
12 training and continuing education requirement;
13 providing an effective date; and declaring an
14 emergency.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 1, Chapter 472, O.S.L.
17 2005 (70 O.S. Supp. 2008, Section 5-190), is amended to read as
18 follows:

19 Section 5-190. A. ~~Before July 1, 2007, every school district~~
20 ~~treasurer shall complete at least twelve (12) hours of instruction~~
21 ~~on school finance laws of this state, accounting, ethics, and the~~
22 ~~duties and responsibilities of a school district treasurer.~~

23 B. ~~Before July 1, 2007, every school district encumbrance clerk~~
24 ~~shall complete at least twelve (12) hours of instruction on school~~
finance laws of this state, accounting, ethics, and the duties and
responsibilities of a school district encumbrance clerk.

1 ~~C.~~ Every school district treasurer and, encumbrance clerk, and
2 any other employee with responsibility for school district funds
3 ~~employed after July 1, 2007,~~ shall be required, within nine (9)
4 months after employment in the position by a school district, to
5 complete ~~the~~ at least twelve (12) hours of instruction required
6 ~~pursuant to subsections A and B of this section~~ on school finance
7 laws of this state, accounting, ethics, and the duties and
8 responsibilities of the school district employee position.

9 ~~D.~~ B. Every school district treasurer and, encumbrance clerk,
10 and any other employee with responsibility for school district funds
11 shall be required to complete a minimum of twelve (12) hours of
12 continuing education every three (3) years, in addition to the
13 requirements of ~~subsections~~ subsection A ~~and B~~ of this section.

14 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2009.

15 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
16 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
17 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
18 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
