6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to motor vehicles; making certain
8 acts unlawful; providing penalties; providing for
9 codification; and providing an effective date.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 11-901c of Title 47, unless
14 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 A. A person commits aggressive driving if both of the following
16 occur:

17 1. During a course of conduct the person commits a violation of
18 Section 11-801 of Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes and at least two
19 of the following violations:

- 20 a. failure to obey traffic-control devices as provided in
21 Section 11-201 of Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes,
22 b. overtaking and passing another vehicle on the right by
23 driving off the pavement or main-traveled portion of
24

1 the roadway as provided in Section 11-304 of Title 47
2 of the Oklahoma Statutes,

3 c. unsafe lane change as provided in Section 11-604 of
4 Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes,

5 d. following a vehicle too closely as provided in Section
6 11-310 of Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes, or

7 e. failure to yield the right-of-way as provided in
8 Sections 11-401 through 11-406 of Title 47 of the
9 Oklahoma Statutes.

10 2. The driving of the person is an immediate hazard to another
11 person or vehicle.

12 B. Any person convicted of aggressive driving shall be guilty
13 of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be punished as provided
14 for in Section 17-101 of Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

15 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2009.
