6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to crimes and punishments;
8 prohibiting the exhibit of certain materials in
9 vehicles; defining terms; providing penalty;
10 providing for codification; and providing an
11 effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1040.56 of Title 21, unless
15 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 A. No material which is harmful to minors shall be exhibited on
17 a television, monitor, or other viewing screen or surface, located
18 within or on a motor vehicle, in any manner visible to other drivers
19 or any person outside the vehicle. As used in this subsection,
20 "material" and "harmful to minors" shall have the same meaning as
21 provided for in Section 1040.75 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma
22 Statutes.

1 B. Any person convicted of violating the provisions of this
2 section shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and subject to a fine of
3 not more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00).

4 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2009.
