6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to roads, bridges and ferries;  
8 requiring installation of certain safety devices;  
9 requiring installations to begin by certain dates;  
10 providing for codification; and providing an  
11 effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 322 of Title 69, unless there is  
15 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 All Oklahoma National and State Highway Systems projects shall  
17 utilize reflectorized raised pavement markers in conjunction with  
18 other reflective marking systems. By January 1, 2010, the  
19 Department of Transportation and the Oklahoma Turnpike Authority  
20 shall begin to install reflectorized raised pavement markers on all  
21 new construction or repaving projects. By November 1, 2010, the  
22 Department of Transportation and Oklahoma Turnpike Authority shall  
23 install reflectorized raised pavement markers on all remaining  
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1 existing highways on the Oklahoma National and State Highway  
2 Systems.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2009.
