6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to the Department of Agriculture,
8 Food, and Forestry; making an appropriation; stating
9 purpose; providing lapse dates; providing an
10 effective date; and declaring an emergency.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma
13 Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry from any monies not
14 otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State
15 Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the sum of Four
16 Million Eight Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$4,850,000.00) or so
17 much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon
18 the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry by law.

19 SECTION 2. The funds appropriated by Section 1 of this act
20 shall be expended to provide operational grants to rural fire
21 departments and shall be limited to Five Thousand Five Hundred
22 Dollars (\$5,500.00) per municipality.

23 SECTION 3. Appropriations made by this act, not including
24 appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for

1 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010 (hereafter FY-10) or may be
2 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011 (hereafter FY-11).
3 Funds budgeted for FY-10 may be encumbered only through June 30,
4 2010, and must be expended by November 15, 2010. Any funds
5 remaining after November 15, 2010, and not budgeted for FY-11, shall
6 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal
7 year. Funds budgeted for FY-11 may be encumbered only through June
8 30, 2011. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2011, shall lapse
9 to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.
10 These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years
11 simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-10, and not required to pay
12 obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-11, after
13 the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared
14 and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds
15 from the FY-10 budget work program and after such revision has been
16 approved by the Office of State Finance.

17 SECTION 4. This act shall become effective July 1, 2009.

18 SECTION 5. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
19 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
20 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
21 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
