6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to energy; amending 74 O.S. 2001,
8 Section 130.4, as amended by Section 1, Chapter 38,
9 O.S.L. 2002 (74 O.S. Supp. 2008, Section 130.4),
10 which relates to the Oklahoma Alternative Fuels
11 Conversion Fund; increasing maximum expenditure
12 amount for installation of a fill or charge station;
13 and declaring an emergency.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2001, Section 130.4, as
16 amended by Section 1, Chapter 38, O.S.L. 2002 (74 O.S. Supp. 2008,
17 Section 130.4), is amended to read as follows:

18 Section 130.4 A. There is hereby created in the State Treasury
19 a revolving fund for the Department of Central Services to be
20 designated as the "Oklahoma Alternative Fuels Conversion Fund". The
21 fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year
22 limitations, and shall consist of all monies received by the
23 Department of Central Services pursuant to Section 130.5 of this
24 title.

1 B. All monies accruing to the credit of the revolving fund
2 shall be expended by the Department of Central Services to reimburse
3 expenses relative to the conversion of government vehicles and
4 school vehicles to have the capability of being fueled or charged by
5 alternative fuels and/or the expenses relative to the installation
6 of a fill station or charge station. The maximum amount expended
7 per vehicle shall be the actual cost of vehicle conversion or Ten
8 Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00), whichever is less. The maximum
9 amount expended per fill station or charge station shall be the
10 actual cost of the installation or ~~One Hundred Fifty Thousand~~
11 ~~Dollars (\$150,000.00)~~ Three Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$300,000.00),
12 whichever is less. The balance on deposit in the fund shall never
13 exceed the sum of Five Million Dollars (\$5,000,000.00).

14 C. Expenditures from the revolving fund shall be made upon
15 warrants issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as
16 prescribed by law with the Director of State Finance for approval
17 and payment.

18 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
19 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
20 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
21 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
