6 An Act relating to crimes and punishments; requiring
7 certain disclosure from persons making telephone
8 calls on behalf of candidates; providing for
9 penalties; providing for reporting of violations;
providing for codification; and providing an
effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 187.3 of Title 21, unless there
15 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 A. No person, as defined by Section 187 of Title 21 of the
17 Oklahoma Statutes, shall make or cause to be made any telephone call
18 on behalf of a candidate, as defined by Section 187 of Title 21 of
19 the Oklahoma Statutes, without disclosing at the beginning of the
20 telephone call the identity of the person making the telephone call
21 and the person, if any, paying for the cost of the telephone call or
22 paying the person making the telephone call.

23 B. Any person in violation of subsection A of this section
24 shall be given a warning for the first offense. For each subsequent

1 violation, the person shall be fined not less than One Thousand
2 Dollars (\$1,000.00), and no more than Five Thousand Dollars
3 (\$5,000.00).

4 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2009.
