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6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to the State Travel Reimbursement  
8 Act; requiring the Director of State Finance to  
9 establish certain guidelines; providing relevant  
10 factors to be considered; requiring establishment of  
11 a website program; stating purpose; providing for  
12 codification; and providing an effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 500.16B of Title 74, unless  
16 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 A. The Director of State Finance shall establish guidelines for  
18 determining the most cost-effective and reasonable mode of travel  
19 under the circumstances from the options authorized pursuant to  
20 Section 500.11 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes. Relevant  
21 factors to be considered shall include, but not be limited to, the  
22 urgency of the travel, the nature of travel required, the type of  
23 vehicle required to carry the necessary number of passengers or  
24 equipment, efficient use of employee time, and employee proximity to  
rental or state vehicles.

1 B. The Director of State Finance shall establish a website  
2 program to assist state agencies in determining the most cost-  
3 effective travel option.

4 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective January 1, 2010.
