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6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to housing; creating the Oklahoma
8 Housing Trust Fund Advisory Committee; providing for
9 membership of Advisory Committee; imposing duties;
10 restricting authority of Advisory Committee;
11 providing for codification; providing an effective
12 date; and declaring an emergency.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2901.5 of Title 74, unless there
16 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 A. There is hereby created the Advisory Committee for the
18 Oklahoma Housing Trust Fund.

19 B. The Advisory Committee shall consist of fifteen (15) members
20 to be appointed or selected as follows:

21 1. One member to be appointed by the Department of Mental
22 Health and Substance Abuse Services;

23 2. One member to be appointed by the Department of Human
24 Services;

- 1 3. One member to be appointed by the Oklahoma Department of
2 Commerce;
- 3 4. One member to be appointed by the Department of Corrections;
- 4 5. One member to be appointed by the Oklahoma Municipal League;
- 5 6. One member to be appointed by the Governor's Interagency
6 Council on Homelessness;
- 7 7. One member to be appointed by the Department of Veterans
8 Affairs;
- 9 8. One member to be appointed by the Oklahoma Employment
10 Security Commission;
- 11 9. One member to be appointed by the Department of
12 Rehabilitation Services;
- 13 10. One member to be appointed by the Oklahoma Association of
14 Community Action Agencies who shall be a person with experience in
15 the development of rural low-income housing;
- 16 11. One member to be appointed by the Rural Rental Housing
17 Association;
- 18 12. One member to be appointed by the Oklahoma Home Builders
19 Association;
- 20 13. One member to be appointed by the Oklahoma State Board of
21 Realtors; and
- 22 14. Two members to be appointed by the Director and the Board
23 of Trustees, one of whom shall be a current owner of low-income
24 housing developed with funding from the Oklahoma Housing Finance

1 Agency and one of whom shall be a tenant of a low-income housing
2 unit or asset developed by the Oklahoma Housing Finance Agency.

3 C. The Advisory Committee shall:

4 1. Annually research statewide housing needs, recommend funding
5 priorities for the year to the Board of Trustees and provide input
6 and direction to the Oklahoma Housing Finance Agency staff regarding
7 rules and applications for the annual funding cycle;

8 2. Review staff funding recommendations prior to the
9 presentation of such recommendations to the Board of Trustees and
10 provide input to the staff and the Board of Trustees when necessary;
11 and

12 3. Review the performance outcomes of the Oklahoma Housing
13 Trust Fund to ensure that results are meeting the funding priorities
14 provided by the Advisory Committee.

15 D. The Advisory Committee shall not:

16 1. Have any role in the fiscal policies of the Oklahoma Housing
17 Finance Agency; or

18 2. Have any role in the oversight of the Oklahoma Housing
19 Finance Agency.

20 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2009.

21 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
22 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
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1 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
2 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
