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6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to juvenile facility funding; stating
8 legislative intent; creating Local Juvenile Facility
9 Support Revolving Fund; providing for deposit of
10 monies; authorizing certain expenditures; stating
11 legislative intent with respect to appropriation for
12 certain audit; providing for codification; providing
13 for noncodification; providing an effective date; and
14 declaring an emergency.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
17 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

18 It is the intent of the Legislature to provide funding for the
19 development and implementation of a pilot program to provide funding
20 for counties and other regional entities to establish locally funded
21 and operated multipurpose juvenile facilities.

22 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
23 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 7302-6.15 of Title 10, unless
24 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

1 There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund
2 for the Department of Human Services to be designated the "Local
3 Juvenile Facility Support Revolving Fund". The fund shall be a
4 continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, and shall
5 consist of all monies received by the Department of Human Services
6 from the appropriations referred to in Section 3 of this act. All
7 monies accruing to the credit of said fund are hereby appropriated
8 and may be budgeted and expended by the Department of Human Services
9 for the purpose of establishing regional juvenile facilities.
10 Expenditures from said fund shall be made upon warrants issued by
11 the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by law with
12 the Director of State Finance for approval and payment.

13 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
14 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

15 It is the intent of the Legislature to make appropriations each
16 fiscal year beginning with the fiscal year ending on June 30, 2010,
17 for a period of five (5) fiscal years. The appropriations shall be
18 deposited into the Local Juvenile Facility Support Revolving Fund
19 created pursuant to Section 2 of this act.

20 SECTION 4. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
21 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

22 It is the intent of the Legislature to appropriate for the
23 fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, such funds as may be required for
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1 the performance of an audit of the Office of Juvenile Affairs with
2 special emphasis on monies expended for youth services programs.

3 SECTION 5. This act shall become effective July 1, 2009.

4 SECTION 6. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
5 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
6 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
7 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
