6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to public finance; amending 62 O.S.
8 2001, Section 45.1, as amended by Section 4, Chapter
9 301, O.S.L. 2003 (62 O.S. Supp. 2008, Section 45.1),
10 which relates to the Oklahoma Program Performance
11 Budgeting and Accountability Act; modifying filing
12 requirement; providing penalty for certain agencies;
13 providing an effective date; and declaring an
14 emergency.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 62 O.S. 2001, Section 45.1, as
16 amended by Section 4, Chapter 301, O.S.L. 2003 (62 O.S. Supp. 2008,
17 Section 45.1), is amended to read as follows:

18 Section 45.1 Sections 45.1 through 45.10 of this title shall be
19 known and may be cited as the "Oklahoma Program Performance
20 Budgeting and Accountability Act". All state agencies are to
21 prepare and submit their budgetary systems in a program format. In
22 addition, all state agencies are to collect and identify data to
23 measure performance of their programs. If any nonappropriated state
24 agency fails to file a report under the Oklahoma Program Performance

1 Budgeting and Accountability Act, the agency shall be subject to a
2 penalty of ten percent (10%) of the agency's fee revenue which shall
3 be apportioned to the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury, or
4 the cost of an auditor to prepare and file a report on behalf of the
5 agency which shall be paid to the Legislative Service Bureau,
6 whichever is greater. The agency shall submit its computations to
7 the Office of State Finance, and the Office of State Finance shall
8 take such steps to cause the revenue of the affected agency to be
9 reduced accordingly.

10 Implementation of this act shall be designed to better
11 prioritize state funding needs, reduce program duplication, enhance
12 budgeting information necessary to improve the efficiency of state
13 operations and improve state services to the public.

14 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2009.

15 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
16 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
17 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
18 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
