6 An Act relating to children; amending Section 9,
7 Chapter 296, O.S.L. 2008 (10 O.S. Supp. 2008, Section
8 405.3), which relates to a child care worker
9 registry; designating section as Rene's Law; and
10 providing an effective date.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 9, Chapter 296, O.S.L.
13 2008 (10 O.S. Supp. 2008, Section 405.3), is amended to read as
14 follows:

15 Section 405.3.

16 A. This section shall be known and may be cited as "Rene's
17 Law".

18 B. On or before July 1, 2010, the Commission for Human Services
19 shall promulgate rules to establish and maintain a child care worker
20 registry, accessible to the public through an on-line database, to
21 address:

22 1. A procedure for recording persons in the registry resulting
23 from:

- a. a finding of abuse or neglect, as defined in Section 7102 of Title 10 of the Oklahoma Statutes, by a person when the abuse or neglect occurred to children while in the care of a child care facility,
- b. a revocation or denial of a child care facility license, and
- c. a specified criminal history of an individual, as defined by rules promulgated by the Oklahoma Commission for Human Services;

2. A procedure to provide notice and an opportunity for review prior to recording a person in the registry;

3. Disclosure requirements for information in the registry; and

4. A procedure to restrict licensure or employment in a child care facility of any person recorded in the child care worker registry.

~~B.~~ C. The child care worker registry shall include, but not be limited to:

1. The full name of the individual;
 2. Information necessary to identify the individual; and
 3. The date the individual was recorded in the registry.
- become effective November 1, 2009.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2009.
