6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to intoxicating liquors; amending
8 Section 1, Chapter 312, O.S.L. 2006, as amended by
9 Section 2, Chapter 365, O.S.L. 2007 (37 O.S. Supp.
10 2009, Section 8.2), which relates to underage
11 drinking; increasing penalties; and providing an
12 effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 1, Chapter 312, O.S.L.
15 2006, as amended by Section 2, Chapter 365, O.S.L. 2007 (37 O.S.
16 Supp. 2009, Section 8.2), is amended to read as follows:

17 Section 8.2 A. No person shall knowingly and willfully permit
18 any individual under twenty-one (21) years of age who is an invitee
19 to the person's residence, any building, structure, or room owned,
20 occupied, leased or otherwise procured by the person or on any land
21 owned, occupied, leased or otherwise procured by the person, to
22 possess or consume any alcoholic beverage as defined by Section 506
23 of ~~Title 37 of the Oklahoma Statutes~~ this title, any controlled

1 dangerous substance as defined in the Uniform Controlled Dangerous
2 Substances Act, or any combination thereof, in such place.

3 B. Any person who violates this section, and such actions cause
4 great bodily injury ~~or the death of a person~~, shall, in addition to
5 any other penalty provided by law, be guilty of a felony, punishable
6 by imprisonment in the custody of the Department of Corrections for
7 not more than ~~five (5)~~ ten (10) years, or a fine of not less than
8 Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$2,500.00) nor more than Five
9 Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00), or by both such fine and imprisonment.

10 Any person who violates this section, and such actions cause the
11 death of a person, shall, in addition to any other penalty provided
12 by law, be guilty of a felony, punishable by life imprisonment in
13 the custody of the Department of Corrections, or a fine of not less
14 than Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) nor more than Twenty Thousand
15 Dollars (\$20,000.00), or by both such fine and imprisonment.

16 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2010.
