6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to state government; amending 74 O.S.  
8 2001, Section 150.23, as last amended by Section 3,  
9 Chapter 169, O.S.L. 2005 (74 O.S. Supp. 2009, Section  
10 150.23), which relates to authority of retired state  
11 employees to retain possession certain sidearms and  
12 badges; authorizing certain retired Department of  
13 Human Services employees retain possession of  
14 sidearms and badges; and providing an effective date.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2001, Section 150.23, as  
16 last amended by Section 3, Chapter 169, O.S.L. 2005 (74 O.S. Supp.  
17 2009, Section 1550.23), is amended to read as follows:

18 Section 150.23 A. An officer, investigator, or agent of the  
19 Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation, the Oklahoma State Bureau of  
20 Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control, the Department of Wildlife  
21 Conservation, the Law Enforcement Division of the Oklahoma Horse  
22 Racing Commission, the State Fire Marshal's Office, the Oklahoma  
23 Tourism and Recreation Department, the Office of Inspector General  
24 of the Department of Human Services or the office of a district

1 attorney shall be entitled to receive, upon retirement by reason of  
2 length of service, the continued custody and possession of the  
3 sidearm and badge carried by such officer, investigator, or agent  
4 immediately prior to retirement.

5 B. An officer, investigator, or agent specified in subsection A  
6 of this section may be entitled to receive, upon retirement by  
7 reason of disability, the continued custody and possession of the  
8 sidearm and badge carried by such officer or agent immediately prior  
9 to retirement upon written approval of the applicable Director of  
10 the appropriate Bureau, Department, Commission, or district  
11 attorney.

12 C. Custody and possession of the sidearm and badge of an  
13 officer, investigator, or agent who dies while employed by any  
14 Bureau, Department, Commission, or office specified in subsection A  
15 of this section may be awarded by the applicable Director of the  
16 appropriate Bureau, Department, Commission, or office to the spouse  
17 or ~~next of kin~~ next of kin of the deceased officer, investigator, or  
18 agent.

19 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2010.
