9 AS INTRODUCED

10 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Center for the
11 Advancement of Science and Technology; making an
12 appropriation; stating purpose; requiring deposit of
13 certain funds; requiring budgeting in certain
14 categories and amounts; providing for duties and
15 compensation of employees; limiting the maximum
16 salary of the Executive Director; providing budgetary
17 limitations; requiring budgeting of certain funds in
18 certain years; providing lapse dates; requiring
19 certain budget procedures; prohibiting certain budget
20 procedures; providing an effective date; and
21 declaring an emergency.

22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

23 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Center
24 for the Advancement of Science and Technology from any monies not
otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State
Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, the sum of
_____ Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary

1 to perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma Center for the
2 Advancement of Science and Technology by law.

3 SECTION 2. From the monies appropriated in Section 1 of this
4 act to the Oklahoma Center for the Advancement of Science and
5 Technology, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00) shall be
6 deposited into the Research Support Revolving Fund created pursuant
7 to Section 5060.11 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

8 SECTION 3. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, the
9 Oklahoma Center for the Advancement of Science and Technology shall
10 budget all funds in the following categories and amounts:

16 SECTION 4. The duties and compensation of employees, not
17 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
18 upon the Oklahoma Center for the Advancement of Science and
19 Technology by law shall be set by the Oklahoma Center for the
20 Advancement of Science and Technology. The salary of the Executive
21 Director of the Oklahoma Center for the Advancement of Science and
22 Technology shall not exceed _____ Dollars (\$0.00) per
23 annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011.
24 The Oklahoma Center for the Advancement of Science and Technology

1 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, shall be subject to the
2 following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees
3 and expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and special
4 projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of
5 Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

9 SECTION 5. Appropriations made by this act, not including
10 appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for
11 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011 (hereafter FY-11) or may be
12 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2012 (hereafter FY-12).
13 Funds budgeted for FY-11 may be encumbered only through June 30,
14 2011, and must be expended by November 15, 2011. Any funds
15 remaining after November 15, 2011, and not budgeted for FY-12, shall
16 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal
17 year. Funds budgeted for FY-12 may be encumbered only through June
18 30, 2012. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2012, shall lapse
19 to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.
20 These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years
21 simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-11, and not required to pay
22 obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-12, after
23 the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared
24 and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds

1 from the FY-11 budget work program and after such revision has been
2 approved by the Office of State Finance.

3 SECTION 6. This act shall become effective July 1, 2010.

4 SECTION 7. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
5 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
6 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
7 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
