10 AS INTRODUCED

11 An Act relating to the State Election Board; making
12 an appropriation; stating purpose; requiring
13 budgeting in certain categories and amounts;
14 providing for duties and compensation of employees;
15 limiting the salary of the Secretary; making certain
16 appropriations nonfiscal; providing an effective
17 date; and declaring an emergency.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

19 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the State Election
20 Board from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General
21 Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June
22 30, 2011, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof
23 as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the State
24 Election Board by law.

1 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, the State
 2 Election Board shall budget all funds in the following categories
 3 and amounts:

10 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not
 11 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
 12 upon the State Election Board by law shall be set by the State
 13 Election Board. The salary of the Secretary of the State Election
 14 Board shall not exceed _____ Dollars (\$0.00) per
 15 annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011.
 16 The State Election Board for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011,
 17 shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-
 18 time-equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures
 19 for capital and special projects, except as may be authorized
 20 pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the
 21 Oklahoma Statutes:

1 SECTION 4. The appropriation made by this act shall not be
2 subject to fiscal year limitations and shall be available for
3 encumbrance and expenditure purposes for a period of thirty (30)
4 months from the date this act is approved.

5 SECTION 5. This act shall become effective July 1, 2010.

6 SECTION 6. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
7 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
8 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
9 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
