9 AS INTRODUCED

10 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Department of
11 Veterans Affairs; making an appropriation; stating
12 purpose; requiring budgeting in certain categories
13 and amounts; providing for duties and compensation of
14 employees; limiting salary of the Director; providing
15 budgetary limitations; requiring and prohibiting
16 certain budget procedures; providing lapse dates;
17 providing an effective date; and declaring an
18 emergency.

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

20 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma
21 Department of Veterans Affairs from any monies not otherwise
22 appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for
23 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, the sum of ____ Dollars
24 (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties
imposed upon the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs by law.

1 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, the
 2 Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs shall budget all funds in
 3 the following categories and amounts:

12 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not
 13 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
 14 upon the Director by law shall be set by the Director. The salary
 15 of the Director shall not exceed _____ Dollars (\$0.00) per
 16 annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011.
 17 The Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs for the fiscal year
 18 ending June 30, 2011, shall be subject to the following budgetary
 19 limitations, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions
 20 of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

1 SECTION 4. Appropriations made by this act, not including
2 appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for
3 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011 (hereafter FY-11) or may be
4 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2012 (hereafter FY-12).
5 Funds budgeted for FY-11 may be encumbered only through June 30,
6 2011, and must be expended by November 15, 2011. Any funds
7 remaining after November 15, 2011, and not budgeted for FY-12, shall
8 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal
9 year. Funds budgeted for FY-12 may be encumbered only through June
10 30, 2012. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2012, shall lapse
11 to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.
12 These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years
13 simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-11, and not required to pay
14 obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-12, after
15 the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared
16 and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds
17 from the FY-11 budget work program and after such revision has been
18 approved by the Office of State Finance.

19 SECTION 5. This act shall become effective July 1, 2010.

20 SECTION 6. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
21 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
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1 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
2 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
