8 AS INTRODUCED

9 An Act relating to the Office of Disability Concerns;
10 making an appropriation to the Office of Disability
Concerns; stating purpose; requiring budgeting in
11 certain categories and amounts; requiring certain
performance measures; providing for the duties and
12 compensation of employees; limiting the salary of the
Director; providing budgetary limitations; providing
13 an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

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15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Office of
17 Disability Concerns from any monies not otherwise appropriated from
18 the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year
19 ending June 30, 2011, the sum of _____ Dollars
20 (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties
21 imposed upon the Office of Disability Concerns by law.

22 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, the Office
23 of Disability Concerns shall budget all funds in the following
24 categories and amounts:

5 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for
6 each budget category.

7 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not
8 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
9 upon the Office of Disability Concerns by law shall be set by the
10 Director. The salary of the Director shall not exceed _____
11 (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June
12 30, 2011. The Office of Disability Concerns for the fiscal year
13 ending June 30, 2011, shall be subject to the following budgetary
14 limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures
15 excluding expenditures for capital and special projects, except as
16 may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of
17 Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

21 SECTION 4. Appropriations made by this act, not including
22 appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for
23 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011 (hereafter FY-11) or may be
24 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2012 (hereafter FY-12).

1 Funds budgeted for FY-11 may be encumbered only through June 30,
2 2011, and must be expended by November 15, 2011. Any funds
3 remaining after November 15, 2011, and not budgeted for FY-12, shall
4 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal
5 year. Funds budgeted for FY-12 may be encumbered only through June
6 30, 2012. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2012, shall lapse
7 to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.
8 These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years
9 simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-11, and not required to pay
10 obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-12, after
11 the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared
12 and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds
13 from the FY-11 budget work program and after such revision has been
14 approved by the Office of State Finance.

15 SECTION 5. This act shall become effective July 1, 2010.

16 SECTION 6. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
17 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
18 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
19 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
