9 AS INTRODUCED

10 An Act relating to the Office of the State Fire
11 Marshal; making an appropriation; stating purpose;
12 requiring budgeting in certain categories and
13 amounts; requiring certain performance measures;
14 providing for the duties and compensation of
15 employees; limiting salary of the State Fire Marshal;
16 providing budgetary limitations; providing exceptions
17 to the budgetary limitations; requiring and
18 prohibiting certain budget practices; providing lapse
19 date; providing an effective date; and declaring an
20 emergency.

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

22 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Office of the
23 State Fire Marshal from any monies not otherwise appropriated from
24 the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year
ending June 30, 2011, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or
so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed
upon the Office of the State Fire Marshal by law.

1 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, the Office
2 of the State Fire Marshal shall budget all funds in the following
3 categories and amounts:

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9 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for
10 each budget category.

11 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not
12 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
13 upon the Office of the State Fire Marshal by law shall be set by the
14 State Fire Marshal of the Office of the State Fire Marshal. The
15 salary of the State Fire Marshal of the Office of the State Fire
16 Marshal shall not exceed _____ Dollars (\$0.00) per annum,
17 payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011. The
18 Office of the State Fire Marshal for the fiscal year ending June 30,
19 2011, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on
20 full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures excluding
21 expenditures for capital and special projects, except as may be
22 authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of
23 the Oklahoma Statutes:

3 SECTION 4. Appropriations made by this act, not including
4 appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for
5 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011 (hereafter FY-11) or may be
6 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2012 (hereafter FY-12).
7 Funds budgeted for FY-11 may be encumbered only through June 30,
8 2011, and must be expended by November 15, 2011. Any funds
9 remaining after November 15, 2011, and not budgeted for FY-12, shall
10 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal
11 year. Funds budgeted for FY-12 may be encumbered only through June
12 30, 2012. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2012, shall lapse
13 to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.
14 These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years
15 simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-11, and not required to pay
16 obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-12, after
17 the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared
18 and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds
19 from the FY-11 budget work program and after such revision has been
20 approved by the Office of State Finance.

21 SECTION 5. This act shall become effective July 1, 2010.

22 SECTION 6. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
23 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
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1 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
2 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
