8 AS INTRODUCED

9 An Act relating to the Workers' Compensation Court;  
10 making appropriation; stating purpose; requiring  
budgeting in certain categories and amounts;  
11 providing for duties and compensation of employees;  
providing budgetary limitations; providing lapse  
12 dates; requiring and prohibiting certain budget  
procedures; providing an effective date; and  
13 declaring an emergency.

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16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Workers'  
18 Compensation Court from any monies not otherwise appropriated from  
19 the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year  
20 ending June 30, 2011, the sum of \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00) or  
21 so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed  
22 upon the Workers' Compensation Court by law.

1 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, the  
 2 Workers' Compensation Court shall budget all funds in the following  
 3 categories and amounts:

8 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not  
 9 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed  
 10 upon the Workers' Compensation Court by law shall be set by the  
 11 Administrator of the Workers' Compensation Court. The Workers'  
 12 Compensation Court for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, shall  
 13 be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-  
 14 equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for  
 15 capital and special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant  
 16 to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma  
 17 Statutes:

21 SECTION 4. Appropriations made by this act, not including  
 22 appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for  
 23 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011 (hereafter FY-11) or may be  
 24 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2012 (hereafter FY-12).

1 Funds budgeted for FY-11 may be encumbered only through June 30,  
2 2011, and must be expended by November 15, 2011. Any funds  
3 remaining after November 15, 2011, and not budgeted for FY-12, shall  
4 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal  
5 year. Funds budgeted for FY-12 may be encumbered only through June  
6 30, 2012. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2012, shall lapse  
7 to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.  
8 These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years  
9 simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-11, and not required to pay  
10 obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-12, after  
11 the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared  
12 and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds  
13 from the FY-11 budget work program and after such revision has been  
14 approved by the Office of State Finance.

15 SECTION 5. This act shall become effective July 1, 2010.

16 SECTION 6. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
17 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
18 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
19 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
