8 AS INTRODUCED

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10 An Act relating to the J.M. Davis Memorial
11 Commission; making an appropriation; stating purpose;
12 requiring budgeting in certain categories and
13 amounts; providing for duties and compensation of
14 employees; limiting the salary of the Executive
15 Director; providing budgetary limitations; making
16 certain appropriations nonfiscal; providing lapse
17 dates; requiring certain budget procedures;
18 prohibiting certain budget procedures; providing an
19 effective date; and declaring an emergency.

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23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

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SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the J.M. Davis
Memorial Commission from any monies not otherwise appropriated from
the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year
ending June 30, 2011, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or so much
thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the
J.M. Davis Memorial Commission by law.

1 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, the J.M.
2 Davis Memorial Commission shall budget all funds in the following
3 categories and amounts:

6 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not
7 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
8 upon the J.M. Davis Memorial Commission by law shall be set by the
9 Executive Director of the J.M. Davis Memorial Commission. The
10 salary of the Executive Director shall not exceed

11 _____ Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable
12 monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011. The J.M. Davis
13 Memorial Commission for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, shall
14 be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-
15 equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for
16 capital and special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant
17 to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma
18 Statutes:

22 SECTION 4. Appropriations made by this act, not including
23 appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for
24 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011 (hereafter FY-11) or may be

1 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2012 (hereafter FY-12).
2 Funds budgeted for FY-11 may be encumbered only through June 30,
3 2011, and must be expended by November 15, 2011. Any funds
4 remaining after November 15, 2011, and not budgeted for FY-12, shall
5 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal
6 year. Funds budgeted for FY-12 may be encumbered only through June
7 30, 2012. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2012, shall lapse
8 to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.
9 These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years
10 simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-11, and not required to pay
11 obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-12, after
12 the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared
13 and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds
14 from the FY-11 budget work program and after such revision has been
15 approved by the Office of State Finance.

16 SECTION 5. This act shall become effective July 1, 2010.

17 SECTION 6. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
18 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
19 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
20 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
