9 AS INTRODUCED

10 An Act relating to the Department of Environmental
11 Quality; making an appropriation; stating purpose;
12 providing for duties and compensation of employees;
13 providing budgetary limitations; providing lapse
14 dates; requiring certain budget procedures;
15 prohibiting certain budget procedures; providing an
16 effective date; and declaring an emergency.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

18 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of
19 Environmental Quality from any monies not otherwise appropriated
20 from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal
21 year ending June 30, 2011, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or
22 so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed
23 upon the Department of Environmental Quality by law.

1 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, the
 2 Department of Environmental Quality shall budget all funds in the
 3 following categories and amounts:

14 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not
 15 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
 16 upon the Department of Environmental Quality by law shall be set by
 17 the Executive Director of the Department of Environmental Quality.
 18 The salary of the Executive Director of the Department of
 19 Environmental Quality shall not exceed _____ Dollars (\$0.00)
 20 per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011.
 21 The Department of Environmental Quality for the fiscal year ending
 22 June 30, 2011, shall be subject to the following budgetary
 23 limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures
 24 excluding expenditures for capital and special projects, except as

1 may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of
2 Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

6 SECTION 4. Appropriations made by this act, not including
7 appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for
8 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011 (hereafter FY-11) or may be
9 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2012 (hereafter FY-12).
10 Funds budgeted for FY-11 may be encumbered only through June 30,
11 2011, and must be expended by November 15, 2011. Any funds
12 remaining after November 15, 2011, and not budgeted for FY-12, shall
13 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal
14 year. Funds budgeted for FY-12 may be encumbered only through June
15 30, 2012. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2012, shall lapse
16 to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.
17 These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years
18 simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-11, and not required to pay
19 obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-12, after
20 the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared
21 and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds
22 from the FY-11 budget work program and after such revision has been
23 approved by the Office of State Finance.

24 SECTION 5. This act shall become effective July 1, 2010.

1 SECTION 6. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
2 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
3 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
4 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
