9 AS INTRODUCED

10 An Act relating to the Will Rogers Memorial
11 Commission; making an appropriation; stating purpose;
12 providing for duties and compensation of employees;
13 providing budgetary limitations; making certain
14 appropriations nonfiscal; providing lapse dates;
15 requiring certain budget procedures; prohibiting
16 certain budget procedures; providing an effective
17 date; and declaring an emergency.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

19 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Will Rogers
20 Memorial Commission from any monies not otherwise appropriated from
21 the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year
22 ending June 30, 2011, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or so much
23 thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the
24 Will Rogers Memorial Commission by law.

1 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, the Will
2 Rogers Memorial Commission shall budget all funds in the following
3 categories and amounts:

6 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not
7 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
8 upon the Will Rogers Memorial Commission by law shall be set by the
9 Will Rogers Memorial Commission. The Will Rogers Memorial
10 Commission for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, shall be
11 subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-
12 equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for
13 capital and special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant
14 to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma
15 Statutes:

19 SECTION 4. Appropriations made by this act, not including
20 appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for
21 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011 (hereafter FY-11) or may be
22 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2012 (hereafter FY-12).
23 Funds budgeted for FY-11 may be encumbered only through June 30,
24 2011, and must be expended by November 15, 2011. Any funds

1 remaining after November 15, 2011, and not budgeted for FY-12, shall
2 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal
3 year. Funds budgeted for FY-12 may be encumbered only through June
4 30, 2012. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2012, shall lapse
5 to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.
6 These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years
7 simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-11, and not required to pay
8 obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-12, after
9 the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared
10 and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds
11 from the FY-11 budget work program and after such revision has been
12 approved by the Office of State Finance.

13 SECTION 5. This act shall become effective July 1, 2010.

14 SECTION 6. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
15 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
16 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
17 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
