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11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1012 of Title 56, unless there
14 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 All medical service providers under the state's SoonerCare
16 program shall collect a five-dollar co-payment at the time services
17 are rendered. The state shall seek a waiver from the Centers for
18 Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) if necessary to implement this
19 policy. The co-payment shall be retained by the service providers
20 as additional incentive to accommodate those seeking services. The
21 co-payment may be waived in whole or in part entirely at the
22 discretion of the medical service provider.

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SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2010.
