6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to motor vehicles; amending 47 O.S.
8 2001, Section 1132, as last amended by Section 2,
9 Chapter 443, O.S.L. 2009 (47 O.S. Supp. 2009, Section
10 1132), which relates to registration fees; providing
11 a reduced registration fee for cars of a certain age;
12 and providing an effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2001, Section 1132, as
15 last amended by Section 2, Chapter 443, O.S.L. 2009 (47 O.S. Supp.
16 2009, Section 1132), is amended to read as follows:

17 Section 1132. A. For all vehicles, unless otherwise
18 specifically provided by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and
19 Registration Act, a registration fee shall be assessed at the time
20 of initial registration by the owner and annually thereafter, for
21 the use of the avenues of public access within this state in the
22 following amounts:

23 1. For the first through the fourth year of registration in
24 this state or any other state, Eighty-five Dollars (\$85.00);

1 2. For the fifth through the eighth year of registration in
2 this state or any other state, Seventy-five Dollars (\$75.00);

3 3. For the ninth through the twelfth year of registration in
4 this state or any other state, Fifty-five Dollars (\$55.00);

5 4. For the thirteenth through the sixteenth year of
6 registration in this state or any other state, Thirty-five Dollars
7 (\$35.00); ~~and~~

8 5. For the seventeenth ~~and any following~~ through the twenty-
9 fourth year of registration in this state or any other state,
10 Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00); and

11 6. For the twenty-fifth and any following year of registration
12 in this state or any other state, Five Dollars (\$5.00).

13 The registration fee provided for in this subsection shall be in
14 lieu of all other taxes, general or local, unless otherwise
15 specifically provided.

16 B. For all-terrain vehicles and motorcycles used exclusively
17 for use off roads or highways purchased on or after July 1, 2005,
18 and for all-terrain vehicles and motorcycles used exclusively for
19 use off roads or highways purchased prior to July 1, 2005, which the
20 owner chooses to register pursuant to the provisions of Section
21 1115.3 of this title, an initial and nonrecurring registration fee
22 of Eleven Dollars (\$11.00) shall be assessed at the time of initial
23 registration by the owner. Nine Dollars (\$9.00) of the registration
24 fee shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement

1 Fund. Two Dollars (\$2.00) of the registration fee shall be retained
2 by the motor license agent. The fees required by subsection A of
3 this section shall not be required for all-terrain vehicles or
4 motorcycles used exclusively off roads and highways.

5 C. For utility vehicles used exclusively for use off roads or
6 highways purchased on or after July 1, 2008, and for utility
7 vehicles used exclusively for use off roads or highways purchased
8 prior to July 1, 2008, which the owner chooses to register pursuant
9 to the provisions of Section 1115.3 of this title, an initial and
10 nonrecurring registration fee of Eleven Dollars (\$11.00) shall be
11 assessed at the time of initial registration by the owner. Nine
12 Dollars (\$9.00) of the registration fee shall be deposited in the
13 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund. Two Dollars (\$2.00) of
14 the registration fee shall be retained by the motor license agent.
15 The fees required by subsection A of this section shall not be
16 required for utility vehicles used exclusively off roads and
17 highways.

18 D. There shall be a credit allowed with respect to the fee for
19 registration of a new vehicle which is a replacement for:

20 1. A new original vehicle which is stolen from the
21 purchaser/registant within ninety (90) days of the date of purchase
22 of the original vehicle as certified by a police report or other
23 documentation as required by the Oklahoma Tax Commission; or
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1 2. A defective new original vehicle returned by the
2 purchaser/registrant to the seller within six (6) months of the date
3 of purchase of the defective new original vehicle as certified by
4 the manufacturer.

5 The credit shall be in the amount of the fee for registration
6 which was paid for the new original vehicle and shall be applied to
7 the registration fee for the replacement vehicle. In no event will
8 the credit be refunded.

9 E. Upon every transfer or change of ownership of a vehicle, the
10 new owner shall obtain title for and, except in the case of salvage
11 vehicles and manufactured homes, register the vehicle within thirty
12 (30) days of change of ownership and pay a transfer fee of Fifteen
13 Dollars (\$15.00) in addition to any other fees provided for in this
14 act. No new decal shall be issued to the registrant. Thereafter,
15 the owner shall register the vehicle annually on the anniversary
16 date of its initial registration in this state and shall pay the
17 fees provided in subsection A of this section and receive a decal
18 evidencing such payment. Provided, used motor vehicle dealers shall
19 be exempt from the provisions of this section.

20 F. In the event a new or used vehicle is not registered, titled
21 and tagged within thirty (30) days from the date of transfer of
22 ownership, the penalty for the failure of the owner of the vehicle
23 to register the vehicle within thirty (30) days shall be One Dollar
24 (\$1.00) per day, provided that in no event shall the penalty exceed

1 One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00). Of each dollar penalty collected
2 pursuant to this subsection:

3 1. Twenty-five cents (\$0.25) shall be apportioned as provided
4 in Section 1104 of this title;

5 2. Twenty-five cents (\$0.25) shall be retained by the motor
6 license agent; and

7 3. Fifty cents (\$.50) shall be deposited in the General Revenue
8 Fund for the fiscal year beginning on July 1, 2009, and for all
9 subsequent fiscal years, shall be deposited in the State Highway
10 Construction and Maintenance Fund.

11 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2010.
