6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to children; amending 10 O.S. 2001,
8 Section 92, which relates to procedure for conferring
9 rights of majority; clarifying language; and
10 providing an effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 10 O.S. 2001, Section 92, is
14 amended to read as follows:

15 Section 92. Any minor desiring to obtain the rights of majority
16 for the purpose named in Section 91 of this title may, by ~~his~~ the
17 next friend of the minor, file a verified petition in the district
18 court of the county in which such minor shall reside, or, if the
19 minor is a nonresident of the State of Oklahoma, said verified
20 petition shall be filed in the county in Oklahoma where said minor
21 owns real estate, setting forth the age of the minor petitioner and
22 that said petitioner is then and has been a bona fide resident of
23 such county for at least one (1) year next before the filing of the
24 petition, or that said minor is a nonresident owning property within

1 the State of Oklahoma, and the cause for which the petitioner seeks
2 to obtain the rights of majority. The petition should state whether
3 or not the parents of the minor are living, and if living, their
4 names and addresses; whether or not a guardian has been appointed
5 for the minor and, if a guardian has been appointed, the guardian's
6 name and address; who has legal custody of the minor and, if the
7 person having legal custody is not a parent or the guardian, the
8 name and address of the person who has custody. And the district
9 court being satisfied that the ~~said~~ petitioner is a person of sound
10 mind and able to transact ~~his~~ the petitioner's own affairs, and that
11 the interests of the petitioner will be thereby promoted, may, in
12 its discretion, order and decree that the petitioner be empowered to
13 exercise the rights of majority for all purposes mentioned in this
14 act.

15 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2010.
