6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to roads, bridges and ferries;
8 designating the Master Sergeant Houston K. Blackburn
9 Memorial Highway; designating the PFC Lonnie D. Loyd,
10 Jr. Memorial Highway; designating the George Freas
11 Memorial Bridge; designating the Fallen Heroes
12 Memorial Bridge; designating the 95th Division
13 Memorial Highway; providing for placement of
14 permanent markers; providing for codification; and
15 declaring an emergency.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
18 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.60 of Title 69, unless
19 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

20 That portion of State Highway 7 from the Atoka city limits
21 extending west to the Johnston County line shall be designated as
22 the "Master Sergeant Houston K. Blackburn Memorial Highway". The
23 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers
24 to be placed on the highway bearing that name.

1 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.61 of Title 69, unless
3 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

4 That portion of State Highway 48 from the junction of State
5 Highway 48 and State Highway 7 extending north to the Johnston
6 County line shall be designated as the "PFC Lonnie D. Loyd, Jr.
7 Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause
8 suitable permanent markers to be placed on the highway bearing that
9 name.

10 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
11 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.62 of Title 69, unless
12 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

13 The bridge on State Highway 31 approximately four (4) miles
14 southwest of Ashland in Coal County shall be designated the "George
15 Freas Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall
16 cause suitable permanent markers to be placed on the bridge bearing
17 that name.

18 SECTION 4. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
19 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.63 of Title 69, unless
20 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

21 The bridge crossing Bull Creek on East State Highway 60
22 approximately one (1) mile east of the junction of East State
23 Highway 60 and State Highway 2 in Craig County shall be designated
24 the "Fallen Heroes Memorial Bridge". The Department of

1 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed
2 on the bridge bearing that name.

3 SECTION 5. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
4 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.4 of Title 69, unless there
5 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

6 That portion of Interstate 44 located in Comanche County from
7 the junction of Interstate 44 and State Highway 7 extending north to
8 mile marker 46 shall be designated as the "95th Division Memorial
9 Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable
10 permanent markers be placed on the highway bearing that name.

11 SECTION 6. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
12 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
13 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
14 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
