5 AS INTRODUCED

6 An Act relating to game and fish; amending Section 1,  
7 Chapter 42, O.S.L. 2008 (28 O.S. Supp. 2009, Section  
8 4-113.1) which relates to certain five year  
9 combination hunting and fishing licenses; providing  
reduction for active duty military members; and  
providing an effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 1, Chapter 42, O.S.L. 2008  
14 (29 O.S. Supp. 2009, Section 4-113.1), is amended to read as  
15 follows:

16 Section 4-113.1 A. All legal residents who have resided in the  
17 state for at least six (6) months may purchase five-year fishing  
18 licenses, five-year hunting licenses or five-year combination  
19 hunting/fishing licenses from the State Wildlife Conservation  
20 Director.

21 B. The Except as provided in subsection C of this section, the  
22 fee for these licenses shall be:

23 1. Five-year fishing license, Seventy-five Dollars (\$75.00);  
24

1        2. Five-year hunting license, Seventy-five Dollars (\$75.00);  
2 and

3        3. Five-year combination hunting/fishing license, One Hundred  
4 Thirty-five Dollars (\$135.00).

5        C. Active members of the military, including, but not limited  
6 to, the Oklahoma Reserve and the National Guard, who are currently  
7 stationed in Oklahoma or are residents of Oklahoma, shall be  
8 eligible to purchase the licenses provided in subsection B of this  
9 section at one-half (1/2) price.

10        D. The use of the licenses provided in this section is subject  
11 to those restrictions provided by statute and the regulations of the  
12 Wildlife Conservation Commission.

13        ~~D.~~ E. Should any lifetime license be lost or destroyed, a  
14 duplicate will be issued by the Department of Wildlife Conservation  
15 for a fee of Five Dollars (\$5.00).

16        ~~E.~~ F. A five-year licensee shall not lose the privileges of  
17 such license by a subsequent transfer of residency.

18        ~~F.~~ G. 1. In addition to the fees imposed pursuant to  
19 subsection B of this section, a person purchasing a five-year  
20 fishing, hunting or combination license shall be required to  
21 purchase a five-year Oklahoma Wildlife Land Stamp. Each person  
22 shall have the stamp in their possession while hunting, fishing, or  
23 taking any wildlife. The fee for the five-year Oklahoma Wildlife

1 Land Stamp shall be Twelve Dollars (\$12.00). The fee for the stamp  
2 shall be distributed as follows:

3 a. Ten Dollars (\$10.00) from each stamp shall be  
4 deposited in the Oklahoma Wildlife Land Fund, created  
5 in Section 4-141 of ~~Title 29 of the Oklahoma Statutes~~  
6 this title, to be used to retire the obligations and  
7 related expenses as authorized pursuant to Section  
8 168.9 of Title 73 of the Oklahoma Statutes or to  
9 purchase, lease, or purchase easements on real  
10 property to be used as public hunting, fishing, and  
11 trapping areas, and

12 b. Two Dollars (\$2.00) from each stamp shall be deposited  
13 in the Oklahoma Wildlife Land Fund, created in Section  
14 4-141 of ~~Title 29 of the Oklahoma Statutes~~ this title,  
15 to be used by the Commission for management of the  
16 real property acquired pursuant to Section 168.9 of  
17 Title 73 of the Oklahoma Statutes or acquired with  
18 proceeds from the Oklahoma Wildlife Land Stamp fee.

19 2. The Oklahoma Wildlife Conservation Commission shall  
20 prescribe, by rule, the form, design, and manner of issuance of the  
21 five-year Oklahoma Wildlife Land Stamp.

22 3. Within one (1) year of the final retirement, redemption, or  
23 defeasance of the obligations created pursuant to Section 168.9 of  
24 Title 73 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the five-year Oklahoma Wildlife

1 Land Stamp and five-year Oklahoma Wildlife Land Stamp fee  
2 requirements provided for in this subsection shall terminate.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2010.
