7 An Act relating to crimes and punishments; making
8 certain acts unlawful; providing penalties; repealing

22 1740.1, 1741, 1742.1, 1742.2, 1742.3 and 1742.4),
23 which relate to larceny; providing for codification;
24 and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1745 of Title 21, unless there
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. When the property taken is of a value of Ten Thousand
Dollars (\$10,000.00) or more, or if the property was taken from the

1 person of another, the offender shall be guilty of a felony
2 punishable by imprisonment in the custody of the Department of
3 Corrections not to exceed ten (10) years, or by a fine not to exceed
4 the value of the property taken or Ten Thousand Dollars
5 (\$10,000.00), whichever is greater, or by both such fine and
6 imprisonment.

7 B. When the property taken is of a value of Five Thousand
8 Dollars (\$5,000.00) or more but less than Ten Thousand Dollars
9 (\$10,000.00), or if the property was taken from any dwelling, the
10 offender shall be guilty of a felony punishable by imprisonment in
11 the custody of the Department of Corrections not to exceed five (5)
12 years, or by a fine not to exceed Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00),
13 or by both such fine and imprisonment.

14 C. When the property taken is of a value of One Thousand
15 Dollars (\$1,000.00) or more but less than Five Thousand Dollars
16 (\$5,000.00), or if the property was taken from any structure, the
17 offender shall be guilty of a felony punishable by incarceration in
18 the county jail not to exceed one (1) year or by imprisonment in the
19 custody of the Department of Corrections not to exceed two (2)
20 years, or by a fine not to exceed Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00),
21 or by both such fine and imprisonment.

22 D. When the property taken is of a value of Five Hundred
23 Dollars (\$500.00) or more but less than One Thousand Dollars
24 (\$1,000.00), the offender shall be guilty of a felony punishable by

1 incarceration in the county jail not to exceed one (1) year, or by a
2 fine not to exceed One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), or by both such
3 fine and imprisonment.

4 E. When the property taken is of a value less than Five Hundred
5 Dollars (\$500.00), the offender shall be guilty of a misdemeanor
6 punishable by incarceration in the county jail not to exceed one (1)
7 year, or by a fine not to exceed Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), or
8 by both such fine and imprisonment.

9 SECTION 2. REPEALER 21 O.S. 2001, Sections 1702, 1703,
10 1704, 1705, 1706, 1707, 1708, 1709, 1710, 1711, 1712 and 1713, are
11 hereby repealed.

12 SECTION 3. REPEALER Section 2, Chapter 186, O.S.L. 2002
13 (21 O.S. Supp. 2009, Section 1713.1), is hereby repealed.

14 SECTION 4. REPEALER 21 O.S. 2001, Sections 1714 and
15 1715, are hereby repealed.

16 SECTION 5. REPEALER 21 O.S. 2001, Section 1716, as
17 amended by Section 1, Chapter 324, O.S.L. 2002 (21 O.S. Supp. 2009,
18 Section 1716), is hereby repealed.

19 SECTION 6. REPEALER 21 O.S. 2001, Sections 1717, 1718,
20 1719, 1719.1 and 1719.2, are hereby repealed.

21 SECTION 7. REPEALER 21 O.S. 2001, Section 1720, as
22 amended by Section 1, Chapter 186, O.S.L. 2002 (21 O.S. Supp. 2009,
23 Section 1720), is hereby repealed.

1 SECTION 8. REPEALER 21 O.S. 2001, Sections 1721, 1722,
2 1723, 1724, 1726, 1727, 1728, 1731 and 1731.1, are hereby repealed.

3 SECTION 9. REPEALER 21 O.S. 2001, Section 1732, as
4 amended by Section 1, Chapter 287, O.S.L. 2009 (21 O.S. Supp. 2009,
5 Section 1732), is hereby repealed.

6 SECTION 10. REPEALER 21 O.S. 2001, Section 1737, is
7 hereby repealed.

8 SECTION 11. REPEALER 21 O.S. 2001, Section 1740, as
9 amended by Section 1, Chapter 21, O.S.L. 2005 (21 O.S. Supp. 2009,
10 Section 1740), is hereby repealed.

11 SECTION 12. REPEALER Section 1, Chapter 54, O.S.L. 2009
12 (21 O.S. Supp. 2009, Section 1740.1), is hereby repealed.

13 SECTION 13. REPEALER Section 1, Chapter 122, O.S.L. 2004
14 (21 O.S. Supp. 2009, Section 1741), is hereby repealed.

15 SECTION 14. REPEALER Sections 1, 2, 3 and 4, Chapter
16 147, O.S.L. 2006 (21 O.S. Supp. 2009, Sections 1742.1, 1742.2,
17 1742.3 and 1742.4), are hereby repealed.

18 SECTION 15. This act shall become effective November 1, 2010.
