6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to environment and natural resources;  
8 directing the Department of Environmental Quality to  
9 design and implement a voluntary environmental  
10 recognition program for marinas; providing for  
11 certification as a Clean Oklahoma Marina; setting  
12 criteria for becoming certified; listing certain  
13 environmental improvement goals; requiring the  
14 Department to provide certain assistance, training  
15 and outreach; directing the Department to promulgate  
16 rules; providing for codification; and providing an  
17 effective date.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

19 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
20 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2-3-108.1 of Title 27A, unless  
21 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

22 A. The Department of Environmental Quality shall design and  
23 implement a statewide program that recognizes operators of public  
24 and private marinas who voluntarily meet high environmental  
standards that help keep Oklahoma waterways clean. A marina that  
meets the environmental standards and requirements as set by the  
Department shall be certified as a "Clean Oklahoma Marina".

1 B. To be certified as a Clean Oklahoma Marina, the operator of  
2 the marina shall fulfill certain requirements as set by the  
3 Department, adopt one or more environmental improvements goals,  
4 report progress in achieving the goals and requirements, and submit  
5 an annual performance report. The environmental improvements goals  
6 a marina are required to adopt may include but are not limited to:

- 7 1. Recycling and reducing solid waste;
- 8 2. Increasing environmentally preferable purchasing;
- 9 3. Conserving water;
- 10 4. Conserving energy and using renewable energy sources;
- 11 5. Reducing nonpoint source pollution; and
- 12 6. Conserving or creating habitat.

13 C. To help marinas meet their environmental improvement goals,  
14 the Department shall provide assistance, training and outreach on  
15 recycling, environmental purchasing, conservation, and pollution  
16 prevention.

17 D. The Department shall promulgate rules necessary to implement  
18 the provisions of this section.

19 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2010.
