7 An Act relating to poor persons; creating certain
8 copayment requirements for participants of Insure
9 Oklahoma program; directing copayment be provided to
certain educational institutions; providing for
codification; and providing an effective date.

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12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1010.1a of Title 56, unless
15 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 All medical service providers participating in the Insure
17 Oklahoma program, except for those service providers associated with
18 the University of Oklahoma and Oklahoma State University, shall
19 collect a Ten Dollar (\$10.00) copayment at the time services are
20 rendered. This copayment shall be in addition to any copayment
21 required pursuant to the program. The state shall seek a waiver
22 from the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services if necessary to
23 implement this policy. The copayment shall be provided to any
24 University of Oklahoma or Oklahoma State University medical training

1 program as provided by rule to be established by the Oklahoma Health
2 Care Authority. The copayment shall be required as an incentive for
3 Insure Oklahoma participants to utilize state educational facilities
4 for their medical needs.

5 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2010.
