6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to elections; requiring candidates to
8 file letter from the Oklahoma Tax Commission
9 regarding state taxes; providing for codification;
10 providing an effective date; and declaring an
11 emergency.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5-101.1 of Title 26, unless
15 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 Any candidate for office shall file along with the declaration
17 of candidacy a letter from the Oklahoma Tax Commission certifying
18 that the candidate is current and in compliance with all state tax
19 obligations administered by the Oklahoma Tax Commission.

20 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2010.

21 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
22 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby

1 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
2 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
