6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to elections; requiring certain  
8 officials to resign prior to filing for office;  
9 providing for codification; providing an effective  
10 date; and declaring an emergency.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5-106.1 of Title 26, unless  
14 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 Any official elected to a statewide office shall resign from  
16 office before filing a Declaration of Candidacy for any other  
17 elected position.

18 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2010.

19 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
20 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
21 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
22 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
