6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to animals; mandating law enforcement
8 agencies to identify and document loose domestic
9 animals; requiring law enforcement agencies to keep a
10 registry of loose domestic animals; providing for
11 codification; and providing an effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 100 of Title 4, unless there is
15 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 If a law enforcement agency responds to a call that involves a
17 domestic animal that is allowed to run at large or has escaped
18 confinement, it shall be the duty of the law enforcement agency to
19 determine the identity of the domestic animal's owner and take a
20 photograph of the animal. The law enforcement agency shall keep a
21 registry including the photograph of the loose domestic animal and
22 its owner's name for future identification purposes.
