6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to probate procedure; authorizing an
8 executor or administrator to have control of certain
9 social networking, microblogging or e-mail accounts
of the deceased; providing for codification; and
providing an effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 269 of Title 58, unless there is
15 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 The executor or administrator of an estate shall have the power,
17 where otherwise authorized, to take control of, conduct, continue,
18 or terminate any accounts of a deceased person on any social
19 networking website, any microblogging or short message service
20 website or any e-mail service websites.

21 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2010.
