5 AS INTRODUCED

6 An Act relating to poor persons; amending Section 1,
7 Chapter 411, O.S.L. 2004 (56 O.S. Supp. 2009, Section
8 3021), which relates to the Oklahoma 2-1-1 Advisory
9 Collaborative; creating the 2-1-1 Oklahoma
10 Coordinating Council; stating responsibilities;
11 providing for development of bylaws; and providing an
12 effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 1, Chapter 411, O.S.L.
15 2004 (56 O.S. Supp. 2009, Section 3021), is amended to read as
16 follows:

17 Section 3021. A. The Oklahoma 2-1-1 Advisory Collaborative,
18 created pursuant to Oklahoma Corporation Commission Rules (OAC
19 165:55-7-2.1, dated July 15, 2003), is hereby ~~designated the~~
20 ~~official state coordinating entity for all 2-1-1 Call Centers in~~
21 ~~Oklahoma. The Collaborative shall serve as the vehicle to develop~~
22 ~~an integrated 2-1-1 service map for the state and as the certifying~~
23 ~~body for information and referral providers who wish to become 2-1-1~~
24 ~~Call Centers~~ renamed the 2-1-1 Oklahoma Coordinating Council.

1 B. The Council shall have the following responsibilities:

2 1. Develop and maintain a statewide coordinated approach for
3 the promotion of a 2-1-1 system to be designated "2-1-1 Oklahoma";

4 2. Develop and maintain an integrated statewide 2-1-1 service
5 that avoids overlap of 2-1-1 call centers in Oklahoma;

6 3. Develop and maintain certification standards for providers
7 that operate as 2-1-1 call centers in Oklahoma;

8 4. Assure that each 2-1-1 call center is accountable and
9 maintains compliance with Oklahoma Corporation Commission standards,
10 and develop and maintain a process for 2-1-1 call center
11 accountability and compliance with state and national standards and
12 any contractual obligations;

13 5. Provide leadership and coordination for 2-1-1 call centers
14 in the event of large-scale emergencies and to meet homeland
15 security needs;

16 6. Develop and implement a statewide, outcome-driven strategic
17 plan for 2-1-1 Oklahoma;

18 7. Advocate for funding to support and sustain 2-1-1 system
19 delivery;

20 8. Coordinate with national, state and local partners in the
21 provision of 2-1-1 services; and

22 9. Using an established formula, provide recommendations to the
23 administering entity responsible for the allocations of funds
24 appropriated for 2-1-1 Oklahoma.

1 C. The current members of the Oklahoma 2-1-1 Advisory
2 Collaborative shall develop bylaws for the Council by February 1,
3 2011. Said bylaws shall identify a process for selecting membership
4 on the Council, terms of office and procedures for replacing
5 members. The bylaws shall require that an equitable ratio of state
6 agency representation to private sector representation be maintained
7 on the Council.

8 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2010.

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
