5 AS INTRODUCED

6 An Act relating to poor persons; providing discretion  
7 to the Department of Human Services in establishing  
8 certain training programs; providing for  
9 codification; and providing an effective date.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 198.10a of Title 56, unless  
14 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 The Department of Human Services shall pursue and utilize the  
16 most cost-efficient and highest quality training methodologies  
17 available in training direct support staff with the primary focus  
18 being on the safety and well-being of the individuals being  
19 supported through this service delivery system. Further, the  
20 Department shall have sole discretion as to what forms and delivery  
21 methods that training shall take, however the Department shall  
22 maintain documentation regarding the efficacy of the training  
23 delivery program.
