6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to roads, bridges and ferries;
8 designating the Tribal Elder Parrish Williams
9 Memorial Highway; designating the Martin Luther King,
10 Jr. Memorial Highway; providing for placement of
11 permanent markers; providing for codification; and
12 providing effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.60 of Title 69, unless
16 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 That portion of State Highway 177 from White Eagle Road
18 extending south to Eagles Nest Road shall be designated as "Tribal
19 Elder Parrish Williams Memorial Highway". The Department of
20 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed
21 on the highway bearing that name.

22 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
23 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.61 of Title 69, unless
24 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

1 That portion of U.S. Highway 77 from the junction of U.S.
2 Highway 77 and South Avenue in Ponca City extending south to the
3 junction of U.S. Highway 77 and East Harding Road shall be
4 designated as "Martin Luther King, Jr. Memorial Highway". The
5 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers
6 to be placed on the highway bearing that name.

7 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2010.
