6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to the Greenwood District; amending  
8 Section 14, Chapter 504, O.S.L. 2004, as last amended  
9 by Section 3, Chapter 311, O.S.L. 2009 (47 O.S. Supp.  
10 2009, Section 1135.5), which relates to special  
11 license plates; creating the Historic Greenwood  
12 District License Plate; providing for deposits into  
13 specified fund; providing income tax checkoff for the  
14 Historic Greenwood District; allowing taxpayer to  
15 designate portion of tax liability into fund;  
16 limiting amount that can be designated; directing  
17 placement of funds; creating the Historic Greenwood  
18 District Revolving Fund; allowing Department of  
19 Commerce to distribute monies in fund; specifying  
20 method of payment of funds; allowing refund for  
21 certain donations; providing time limit for refund;  
22 providing for codification; and providing an  
23 effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 14, Chapter 504, O.S.L.  
2004, as last amended by Section 3, Chapter 311, O.S.L. 2009 (47  
O.S. Supp. 2009, Section 1135.5), is amended to read as follows:

Section 1135.5 A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby  
authorized to design and issue appropriate official special license

1 plates to persons wishing to demonstrate support and provide  
2 financial assistance as provided by this section.

3 Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other  
4 person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of  
5 ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used  
6 on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been  
7 registered for the current year with a motor license agent.

8 Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax  
9 Commission or a motor license agent. The Tax Commission shall  
10 annually notify by mail all persons issued special license plates.  
11 The notice shall contain all necessary information and shall contain  
12 instructions for the renewal procedure upon presentation to a motor  
13 license agent or the Tax Commission. The license plates shall be  
14 issued on a staggered system.

15 The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a  
16 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept  
17 applications for special license plates authorized under this  
18 section. The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's  
19 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount  
20 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary  
21 information directly into such system and generate a receipt  
22 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents  
23 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for  
24 registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for

1 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the  
2 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

3 If fewer than one hundred of any type of special license plates  
4 authorized prior to January 1, 2004, are issued prior to January 1,  
5 2006, the Tax Commission shall discontinue issuance and renewal of  
6 that type of special license plate. Any such authorized special  
7 license plate registrant shall be allowed to display the license  
8 plate upon the designated vehicle until the registration expiration  
9 date. After such time the expired special license plate shall be  
10 removed from the vehicle.

11 For special license plates authorized on or after July 1, 2004,  
12 no special license plates shall be developed or issued by the Tax  
13 Commission until the Commission receives one hundred prepaid  
14 applications therefor. The prepaid applications must be received by  
15 the Tax Commission within one hundred and eighty (180) days of the  
16 effective date of the authorization or the authority to issue shall  
17 be null and void. In the event one hundred prepaid applications are  
18 not received by the Tax Commission within such prescribed time  
19 period any payment so received shall be refunded accordingly.

20 B. The special license plates provided by this section are as  
21 follows:

22 1. University or College Supporter License Plates - such plates  
23 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate  
24 support to any state-supported or private university or college. As

1 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be  
2 apportioned as provided in Section 1104.1 of this title;

3       2. Environmental Awareness License Plates - such plates shall  
4 be designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax  
5 Commission by the Department of Environmental Quality in  
6 consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any  
7 person wishing to demonstrate support to implement the statewide  
8 general public environmental education program created pursuant to  
9 the provisions of the Oklahoma Environmental Quality Code. Such  
10 plates shall be designed and issued to any person in any combination  
11 of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for  
12 personalized license plates. A dealer's license plate issued  
13 pursuant to Section 1116.1 or 1128 of this title may be designated  
14 an Environmental Awareness License Plate upon payment of the fee  
15 imposed by this section and any other registration fees required by  
16 the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act. As provided in  
17 this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned  
18 pursuant to Section 1104.2 of this title;

19       3. Firefighter License Plates - such plates shall be designed  
20 for any career or retired firefighter, volunteer or paid.  
21 Firefighters may apply for firefighter plates for up to four  
22 vehicles with a rated capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a  
23 motorcycle upon proof of a fire department membership by either an  
24 identification card or letter from the chief of the fire department.

1 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of  
2 eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to  
3 provide proof of eligibility annually. The surviving spouse of any  
4 deceased firefighter, if the spouse has not since remarried, may  
5 apply for a firefighter license plate for one vehicle with a rated  
6 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a motorcycle upon  
7 proof that the deceased firefighter was a member of a fire  
8 department by either an identification card or letter from the chief  
9 of the fire department.

10 Except for motorcycles, the license plate shall have the legend  
11 "Oklahoma" in the color Pantone 186C Red and shall contain no more  
12 than three letters and three numbers in the color Pantone 301C Blue.  
13 Between the letters and numbers shall be the Firefighter Maltese  
14 Cross Logo in the color Pantone 186C Red outlined in the color  
15 Pantone 301C Blue. Below the letters and the logo shall be the word  
16 "Firefighter" in the color Pantone 186C Red. The license plate for  
17 motorcycles may be of a similar design as space permits or a new  
18 design in order to meet the space requirements of a motorcycle  
19 license plate. The plates shall not be subject to the design  
20 requirements of any other license plates prescribed by law other  
21 than the space for the placement of the yearly decals for each  
22 succeeding year of registration after the initial issue.

23 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected  
24 shall be deposited to the Oklahoma State Firemen's Museum Building &

1 Memorial Fund for support of the Oklahoma Firefighter Fallen and  
2 Living Memorial;

3 4. Wildlife Conservation License Plates - such plates shall be  
4 designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax  
5 Commission by the Oklahoma Department of Wildlife Conservation in  
6 consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any  
7 person wishing to demonstrate support for wildlife conservation in  
8 this state through the Wildlife Diversity Fund, provided for in  
9 Section 3-310 of Title 29 of the Oklahoma Statutes. Such plates may  
10 be designed and issued to any person as for personalized license  
11 plates.

12 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected  
13 shall be apportioned pursuant to subsection D of Section 3-310 of  
14 Title 29 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

15 5. Child Abuse Prevention License Plates - such plates shall be  
16 designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax  
17 Commission by the Office of Child Abuse Prevention in the State  
18 Department of Health and the Oklahoma Committee to Prevent Child  
19 Abuse, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for  
20 the prevention of child abuse.

21 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected  
22 shall be deposited in the Child Abuse Prevention Fund;

23 6. United States Olympic Committee Supporter License Plates -  
24 such plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to

1 demonstrate support for the United States Olympic Committee. The  
2 plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers  
3 and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized  
4 license plates. The plate shall contain the official United States  
5 Olympic Committee logo. The Tax Commission shall be authorized, if  
6 necessary, to enter into a licensing agreement with the United  
7 States Olympic Committee for any licensing fees which may be  
8 required in order to use the United States Olympic Committee logo or  
9 design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment of not  
10 more than Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) for each license plate  
11 issued;

12 7. Oklahoma History License Plates - such plates shall be  
13 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate interest in  
14 Oklahoma history. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee  
15 collected shall be deposited to the Oklahoma Historical Society  
16 Revolving Fund to be used for educational purposes;

17 8. Historic Route 66 License Plates - such plates shall be  
18 designed to honor historic Route 66, also known as the "Mother  
19 Road". As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected  
20 shall be apportioned to the Oklahoma Historical Society Revolving  
21 Fund to be distributed to the Route 66 Museum located in Clinton,  
22 Oklahoma;

23 9. Heart of the Heartland License Plates - such plates shall be  
24 designed and issued to any person wishing to honor the victims of

1 the terrorist bombing attack on the Alfred P. Murrah Federal  
2 Building in downtown Oklahoma City on April 19, 1995. As provided  
3 in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited  
4 in the Heart of the Heartland Scholarship Fund, as established in  
5 Section 2282 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

6 10. Emergency Medical Technician License Plates - such plates  
7 shall be designed and issued to any person who is an emergency  
8 medical technician. Such persons may apply for an emergency medical  
9 technician license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying  
10 capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of an emergency medical  
11 technician's license. The license plate shall be designed in  
12 consultation with the state association of emergency medical  
13 technicians. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee  
14 collected shall be apportioned to the county of residence of the  
15 person purchasing the plates to be equally apportioned by the county  
16 to the city and county volunteer fire departments in the county;

17 11. Fight Breast Cancer License Plates - such plates shall be  
18 designed to demonstrate support for the prevention and treatment of  
19 breast cancer in this state. As provided in this section, an amount  
20 of the fee collected shall be apportioned to the Breast Cancer Act  
21 Revolving Fund;

22 12. Crime Victims Awareness License Plates - such plates shall  
23 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate  
24 awareness of and support for victims of crimes. The license plates

1 shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Crime Victims  
2 Centre. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected  
3 shall be apportioned to the Attorney General's Revolving Fund for  
4 the Office of the Attorney General, which is hereby directed to use  
5 such funds to contract with a statewide nonprofit organization to  
6 provide services to crime victims;

7 13. Oklahoma Safe Kids Association License Plates - such plates  
8 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate  
9 support and awareness of the Oklahoma Safe Kids Association. The  
10 license plate shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma  
11 Safe Kids Association. As provided in this section, an amount of  
12 the fee collected shall be deposited in the Children's Hospital -  
13 Oklahoma Safe Kids Association Revolving Fund to be distributed to  
14 the Oklahoma Safe Kids Association program;

15 14. Four-H Club License Plates - such plates shall be designed,  
16 subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission by the  
17 Four-H Foundation, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate  
18 support of the Four-H Club. Such plates may be designed and issued  
19 to any person as for personalized license plates. As provided in  
20 this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned to  
21 the OSU Extension Service License Plate Revolving Fund created in  
22 Section 1104.4 of this title;

23 15. Agricultural Awareness License Plates - such plates shall  
24 be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax

1 Commission, by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and  
2 Forestry in consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued  
3 to any person wishing to demonstrate support of the Department's Ag  
4 in the Classroom Education Program. As provided in this section, an  
5 amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in  
6 Section 1104.3 of this title;

7 16. Oklahoma Statehood Centennial License Plates - such plates  
8 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to commemorate  
9 the centennial of Oklahoma's admission to statehood in 1907. The  
10 license plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma  
11 Capitol Complex and Centennial Commemoration Commission. As  
12 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be  
13 deposited in the Oklahoma Capitol Complex and Centennial  
14 Commemoration Commission Revolving Fund created in Section 98.5 of  
15 Title 73 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

16 17. Support Education License Plates - such plates shall be  
17 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission  
18 by the State Department of Education in consultation with the  
19 Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any person wishing to  
20 demonstrate support for education in this state. All motor license  
21 agents shall display a sample of the Support Education License plate  
22 in the area of the business accessed by the public. Twenty-three  
23 Dollars (\$23.00) of the fee collected shall be apportioned as  
24 follows:

- a. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the Education Reform Revolving Fund,
- b. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the Higher Education Revolving Fund,
- c. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the State Career Technology Fund, and
- d. eighty-five percent (85%) of the fee shall be deposited to the Teachers' Retirement Benefit Fund as set forth in Section 17-108 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

However, when the Teachers' Retirement Benefit Fund attains a seventy percent (70%) funded ratio based on an annual actuarial valuation as required by law, the amount of the fee shall be apportioned equally pursuant to subparagraphs a, b and c of this paragraph;

18. Retired Oklahoma Highway Patrol Officers License Plates - such plates shall be designed and issued to any retired officer of the Oklahoma Highway Patrol. The license plate shall have the legend "Oklahoma" and shall contain, in the center of the plate, the Highway Patrol Officers patch using the same colors and pattern as used in the patch. Centered on the bottom of the license plate shall be the word "Retired". The letters "TRP" shall be used in combination with three numbers on either side of the insignia or emblem. The color of the letters and numbers shall be brown.

1 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of  
2 eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to  
3 provide proof of eligibility annually. The surviving spouse of any  
4 deceased retired officer of the Oklahoma Highway Patrol, if the  
5 spouse has not since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is  
6 terminated by death, divorce, or annulment, may apply for a Retired  
7 Oklahoma Highway Patrol Officers license plate. As provided in this  
8 section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited into the  
9 Law Enforcement Retirement Fund;

10 19. Boy Scouts of America Supporter License Plates - such  
11 plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to  
12 demonstrate support for the Boy Scouts of America. The plates shall  
13 be issued to any person in any combination of numbers and letters  
14 from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates.  
15 The plate shall contain the official Boy Scouts of America logo.  
16 The Tax Commission shall be authorized, if necessary, to enter into  
17 a licensing agreement with the Boy Scouts of America for any  
18 licensing fees which may be required in order to use the Boy Scouts  
19 of America logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide  
20 for a payment to the Boy Scouts of America of not more than Twenty  
21 Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

22 20. Urban Forestry and Beautification License Plates - such  
23 plates shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the  
24 Tax Commission, by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and

1 Forestry in consultation with nonprofit organizations in this state  
2 that develop and operate programs to encourage urban forestry and  
3 beautification, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate  
4 support of such programs. As provided in this section, an amount of  
5 the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in Section 1104.5  
6 of this title;

7 21. Oklahoma State Parks Supporter License Plates - such plates  
8 shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax  
9 Commission by the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department, and  
10 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma  
11 state parks system. Twenty-three Dollars (\$23.00) of the fee  
12 collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation  
13 Department Revolving Fund. Such money shall be designated for and  
14 may only be expended for the support of Oklahoma state parks;

15 22. Adoption Creates Families License Plates - such plates  
16 shall be issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support of  
17 pregnant women who are committed to placing their children for  
18 adoption and wishing to provide assistance to guardians, adoptive  
19 parents and other created families to assist in the adoption and  
20 placement of children in permanent, safe homes. The license plates  
21 shall be designed and final terminology delivered in consultation  
22 with the Oklahoma Adoption Coalition and the Department of Human  
23 Services. Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) of the fee collected shall  
24 be deposited in a revolving fund established in the State Treasury

1 for and to be used by the Department of Human Services for the  
2 implementation of the Investing in Stronger Oklahoma Families Act  
3 specifically for created families;

4 23. Choose Life License Plates - such plates shall be designed,  
5 subject to criteria presented to the Tax Commission, by Choose Life,  
6 Inc., and issued to any person who wishes to demonstrate support of  
7 organizations that encourage adoption as a positive choice for women  
8 with unplanned pregnancies. As provided in this section, an amount  
9 of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Choose Life  
10 Assistance Program Revolving Fund established in Section 1104.6 of  
11 this title;

12 24. Future Farmers of America License Plate - such plates shall  
13 be designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for  
14 the Oklahoma FFA (formerly known as Future Farmers of America). The  
15 license plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma  
16 FFA Foundation Board of Directors. As provided in this section, an  
17 amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in  
18 Section 1104.7 of this title;

19 25. Lions Club License Plates - such plates shall be designed  
20 and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for the Lions  
21 Club of Oklahoma. The plates shall be issued to any person in any  
22 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven,  
23 as for personalized license plates. The license plates shall be  
24 designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Lions Service Foundation

1 and shall contain the official logo of the International Association  
2 of Lions Clubs. The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter  
3 into a licensing agreement with the Oklahoma Lions Service  
4 Foundation. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to  
5 the Oklahoma Lions Service Foundation of not more than Ten Dollars  
6 (\$10.00) for each license plate issued;

7 26. Color Oklahoma License Plates - such plates shall be  
8 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission  
9 by the Oklahoma Native Plant Society, and issued to any person  
10 wishing to demonstrate support for preserving and planting  
11 wildflowers and native plants in Oklahoma and to promote Oklahoma's  
12 wildflower heritage through education. As provided in this section,  
13 an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in  
14 Section 1104.8 of this title;

15 27. Girl Scouts of the United States of America Supporter  
16 License Plates - such plates shall be designed and issued to any  
17 person wishing to demonstrate support for the Girl Scouts of the  
18 United States of America. The plates shall be issued to any person  
19 in any combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of  
20 seven, as for personalized license plates. The plate shall contain  
21 the official Girl Scouts of the United States of America logo. The  
22 Tax Commission shall be authorized, if necessary, to enter into a  
23 licensing agreement with the Girl Scouts of the United States of  
24 America for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use

1 the Girl Scouts of the United States of America logo or design. The  
2 licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to the Girl Scouts  
3 of Magic Empire Council, acting on behalf of all Oklahoma Girl Scout  
4 councils, of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license  
5 plate issued;

6 28. Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon License Plates - such  
7 plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to  
8 demonstrate support for the Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon. The  
9 plate shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma City  
10 Memorial Marathon. The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter  
11 into a licensing agreement with the Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon  
12 for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use the  
13 Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon logo or design. The licensing  
14 agreement shall provide for a payment to the Oklahoma City Memorial  
15 Marathon of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license  
16 plate issued;

17 29. Oklahoma Scenic Rivers License Plate - such plates shall be  
18 designed to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma Scenic Rivers. The  
19 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Scenic  
20 Rivers Commission. Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) of the fee shall be  
21 apportioned to the Oklahoma Scenic Rivers Commission;

22 30. Fight Cancer License Plate - such plates shall be designed  
23 to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma Central Cancer Registry.  
24 The plate shall contain the American Cancer Society logo. The

1 American Cancer Society logo shall be used in accordance with the  
2 American Cancer Society's branding guidelines and shall only be  
3 utilized to support the Oklahoma Central Cancer Registry. Twenty  
4 Dollars (\$20.00) of the fee shall be apportioned to the Oklahoma  
5 Central Cancer Registry Revolving Fund;

6 31. Animal Friendly License Plate - such plates shall be  
7 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for  
8 controlling the overpopulation of dogs and cats through educational  
9 and sterilization efforts. The plates shall be designed in  
10 consultation with the Veterinary Medical Association. Twenty  
11 Dollars (\$20.00) of the fee collected shall be designated by the  
12 purchaser of the plate to be deposited in the Oklahoma Pet  
13 Overpopulation Fund created in Section 2368.13 of Title 68 of the  
14 Oklahoma Statutes or the Animal Friendly Revolving Fund created in  
15 Section 1104.10 of this title;

16 32. Patriot License Plate - such plates shall be designed in  
17 consultation with the Military Department of Oklahoma and issued to  
18 any person wishing to demonstrate support for Oklahoma residents who  
19 are members of the Oklahoma National Guard and deployed on active  
20 duty. The plates shall be issued to any person in any combination  
21 of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for  
22 personalized license plates. As provided in this section, a portion  
23 of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Patriot License Plate  
24 Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.11 of this title;

1           33. Armed Forces Veterans Motorcycle License Plate - such  
2 plates shall be designed for use on a motorcycle in consultation  
3 with A Brotherhood Aiming Toward Education of Oklahoma, Inc.  
4 (ABATE), and issued to any honorably discharged former member of the  
5 United States Armed Forces wishing to demonstrate support for the  
6 45th Infantry Division Museum. Persons applying for such license  
7 plate must show proof of past military service. As provided in this  
8 section, a portion of the fee collected shall be deposited in the  
9 45th Infantry Division Museum Fund created in Section 235.1 of Title  
10 44 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

11           34. Global War on Terrorism License Plate - such plate shall be  
12 designed in consultation with the Military Department of Oklahoma  
13 and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for Oklahoma  
14 residents who are members of the Armed Forces of the United States  
15 or Oklahoma National Guard that have served in the Global War on  
16 Terrorism. The plate shall be issued to any person in any  
17 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of six. As  
18 provided in this section, a portion of the fee collected shall be  
19 deposited in the 45th Infantry Division Museum Fund created in  
20 Section 235.1 of Title 44 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

21           35. Boys and Girls Clubs of America Supporter License Plates -  
22 such plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to  
23 demonstrate support for the Boys and Girls Clubs of America. The  
24 plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers

1 and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized  
2 license plates. The plate shall contain the official Boys and Girls  
3 Clubs of America logo. The Tax Commission, if necessary, may enter  
4 into a licensing agreement with the Boys and Girls Clubs of America  
5 for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use the  
6 Boys and Girls Clubs of America logo or design. The licensing  
7 agreement shall provide for a payment to the Boys and Girls Clubs of

9 plate issued;

10 36. Oklahoma Quarter Horse License Plates - such plates shall  
11 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support  
12 for the American Quarter Horse in Oklahoma. The plate shall be  
13 designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Quarter Horse  
14 Association. As provided in this section, a portion of the fee  
15 collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Quarter Horse Revolving  
16 Fund created in Section 1104.12 of this title;

17 37. Oklahoma Association for the Deaf License Plate - such  
18 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma  
19 Association for the Deaf and issued to any person wishing to  
20 demonstrate support for Oklahoma residents who are deaf. The plates  
21 shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers and  
22 letters from one to maximum of seven, as for personalized license  
23 plates. As provided in this section, a portion of the fee collected  
24

1 shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Association for the Deaf License  
2 Plate Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.15 of this title;

3 38. Oklahoma City Zoo License Plate - such plates shall be  
4 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma  
5 City Zoo. The license plates shall be designed in consultation with  
6 the Oklahoma Zoological Society, Inc. As provided in this section,  
7 an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma  
8 Zoological Society Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.13 of this  
9 title;

10 39. March of Dimes License Plate - such plates shall be issued  
11 to persons wishing to demonstrate support for the March of Dimes  
12 mission to improve the health of babies by preventing birth defects,  
13 premature birth and infant mortality. The license plates shall be  
14 designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Chapter March of Dimes.  
15 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be  
16 deposited in the Oklahoma Prevent Birth Defects, Premature Birth and  
17 Infant Mortality Fund established in Section 1104.14 of this title;

18 40. Support Our Troops Supporter License Plates - such plates  
19 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate  
20 support for Support Our Troops Incorporated. The plates shall be  
21 issued to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from  
22 one to a maximum of six. The plate shall contain the official  
23 Support Our Troops Incorporated logo which includes the mark  
24 "Support Our Troops" across the bottom of the plate. The Tax

1 Commission, if necessary, may enter into a licensing agreement with  
2 Support Our Troops Incorporated for any licensing fees which may be  
3 required in order to use the Support Our Troops Incorporated logo or  
4 design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to  
5 Support Our Troops Incorporated of Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) for  
6 each license plate issued;

7 41. Folds of Honor Supporter License Plate - such plates shall  
8 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support  
9 for Folds of Honor Incorporated, a nonprofit charitable organization  
10 exempt from taxation pursuant to the provisions of the Internal  
11 Revenue Code, 26 U.S.C., Section 501(c)(3), providing academic and  
12 vocational training scholarships to dependents of military  
13 servicemen and servicewomen who were either killed or wounded in  
14 action due to military service in the war in Iraq or Afghanistan.  
15 The plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of  
16 numbers and letters from one to a maximum of six. The plate shall  
17 be designed in consultation with Folds of Honor Incorporated and  
18 shall contain the official Folds of Honor Incorporated logo which  
19 includes the mark "Folds of Honor" across the bottom of the plate.  
20 The Tax Commission, if necessary, may enter into a licensing  
21 agreement with Folds of Honor Incorporated for any licensing fees  
22 which may be required in order to use the Folds of Honor  
23 Incorporated logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide

1 for a payment to Folds of Honor Incorporated of Twenty-five Dollars  
2 (\$25.00) for each license plate issued; ~~and~~

3 42. Oklahoma City Thunder License Plate - such plates shall be  
4 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for  
5 the Oklahoma City Thunder. The license plate shall be designed in  
6 consultation with the Oklahoma City Thunder organization. The Tax  
7 Commission shall be authorized, if necessary, to enter into a  
8 licensing agreement with the Oklahoma City Thunder organization for  
9 any licensing fees which may be required in order to use the  
10 Oklahoma City Thunder logo or design. The licensing agreement shall  
11 provide for a payment of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00); and

12 43. Historic Greenwood District License Plate - such plates  
13 shall be issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for music  
14 festivals held in the Historic Greenwood District in Tulsa,  
15 Oklahoma. The license plates shall be designed in consultation with  
16 the Greenwood Cultural Center. As provided in this section, an  
17 amount of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Historic  
18 Greenwood District Revolving Fund established in Section 2 of this  
19 act.

20 C. The fee for such plates shall be Thirty-five Dollars  
21 (\$35.00) and shall be in addition to all other registration fees  
22 provided by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act. The  
23 fee shall be apportioned as follows:  
24

1           1. Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) or any other amount as provided in  
2 this title of the fee shall be apportioned as provided or deposited  
3 in a fund as specified within the paragraph authorizing the special  
4 license plate;

5           2. Eight Dollars (\$8.00) of the fee shall be deposited in the  
6 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund to be used for the  
7 administration of the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act;  
8 and

9           3. Any remaining amounts of the fee shall be apportioned as  
10 provided in Section 1104 of this title.

11           SECTION 2.           NEW LAW           A new section of law to be codified  
12 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2368.19 of Title 68, unless  
13 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

14           A. Each state individual income tax return form for tax years  
15 which begin after December 31, 2009, and each state corporate tax  
16 return form for tax years beginning after December 31, 2009, shall  
17 contain a provision to allow a donation not to exceed Twenty-five  
18 Dollars (\$25.00) from a tax refund for the benefit of the Historic  
19 Greenwood District.

20           B. Except as otherwise provided for in this section, all monies  
21 generated pursuant to subsection A of this section shall be paid to  
22 the State Treasurer by the Oklahoma Tax Commission and placed to the  
23 credit of the Historic Greenwood District Revolving Fund created in  
24 subsection C of this section.

1 C. There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving  
2 fund to be designated the "Historic Greenwood District Revolving  
3 Fund" and administered by the Oklahoma Department of Commerce. The  
4 fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year  
5 limitations, and shall consist of all the monies received by the  
6 Oklahoma Department of Commerce pursuant to the provisions of  
7 subsection A of this section and Section 1 of this act. All monies  
8 accruing to the credit of the fund are appropriated and may be  
9 budgeted and expended by the Oklahoma Department of Commerce at the  
10 beginning of each fiscal year for the purpose of providing grants to  
11 support and promote music festivals in the Historic Greenwood  
12 District in Tulsa, Oklahoma. Expenditures from the fund shall be  
13 made upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer against claims  
14 filed as prescribed by law with the Director of the Office of State  
15 Finance for approval and payment.

16 D. If a taxpayer makes a donation pursuant to subsection A of  
17 this section in error, such taxpayer may file a claim for refund at  
18 any time within three (3) years from the due date of the tax return.  
19 Such claims shall be filed pursuant to the provisions of Section  
20 2373 of Title 68 of the Oklahoma Statutes. Prior to the  
21 apportionment set forth in this section, an amount equal to the  
22 total amount of refunds made pursuant to this subsection during any  
23 one (1) year shall be deducted from the total donations received  
24 pursuant to this section during the following year and such amount

1 deducted shall be paid to the State Treasurer and placed to the  
2 credit of the Income Tax Withholding Refund Account.

3 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2010.
