6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to healthy foods; enacting the  
8 Healthy Foods at Affordable Prices Retailer Promotion  
9 Act of 2010; creating the Healthy Foods Promotion  
10 Revolving Fund; providing for apportionment of monies  
11 to fund; prescribing procedures for expenditures;  
12 stating authorized purpose of expenditures; providing  
13 for codification; providing an effective date; and  
14 declaring an emergency.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
17 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 6001 of Title 62, unless there  
18 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

19 This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Healthy Foods  
20 at Affordable Prices Retailer Promotion Act of 2010".

21 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
22 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 6002 of Title 62, unless there  
23 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

24 There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund  
for the Oklahoma Department of Commerce to be designated the

1 "Healthy Foods Promotion Revolving Fund". The fund shall be a  
2 continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, and shall  
3 consist of all monies received by the Oklahoma Department of  
4 Commerce from such funds as authorized by law. All monies accruing  
5 to the credit of said fund are hereby appropriated and may be  
6 budgeted and expended by the Oklahoma Department of Commerce for the  
7 purpose of providing forgivable and low interest loans to  
8 supermarkets, grocery stores, and other fresh food retailers for the  
9 promotion of healthy foods at affordable prices. Expenditures from  
10 said fund shall be made upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer  
11 against claims filed as prescribed by law with the Director of State  
12 Finance for approval and payment.

13 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 2010.

14 SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
15 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
16 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
17 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
