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6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to oil and gas; requiring certain
8 motor fuel pumps to deliver printed receipts at the
9 pump; requiring certain information on the printed
10 receipts; specifying duty of the Corporation
11 Commission to inspect motor fuel pumps for
12 compliance; directing the Commission to implement a
13 consumer complaint system; authorizing the Commission
14 to seal and lock motor fuel pumps until compliant;
15 directing the Commission to promulgate rules;
16 providing for codification; and providing an
17 effective date.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

19 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
20 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 348 of Title 52, unless there is
21 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

22 A. Except for motor fuel pumps which dispense motor fuel for
23 fleet sales and other price contract sales, every motor fuel pump
24 which dispenses motor fuel and is manufactured with a built-in
recording element for all transactions conducted with point-of-sale
systems or devices activated by debit cards, credit cards, or cash

1 at the pump shall provide a printed receipt to the customer
2 delivered at the pump which provides the following information:

- 3 1. Total volume of the delivery;
- 4 2. Unit price;
- 5 3. Total computed price; and
- 6 4. Product identity by name, symbol, abbreviation, or code
7 number.

8 B. It shall be the duty of the Corporation Commission to
9 inspect, or to provide for the inspection of, any motor fuel pump
10 whenever in the discretion of the Commission an inspection is
11 necessary to ensure compliance with the provisions of this section
12 and rules promulgated by the Commission. The inspections may be
13 conducted by the Commission in conjunction with other motor fuel
14 pump compliance inspections which the Commission is authorized to
15 conduct pursuant to law. The Commission shall implement a consumer
16 complaint system to accept and process complaints of violations of
17 this section and to conduct an inspection of a motor fuel pump upon
18 receipt of a complaint. The Commission shall have authority
19 whenever a motor fuel pump is found which does not meet the
20 requirements of this section or rules promulgated by the Commission
21 to seal and lock the pump. The seal shall be removed when the
22 violation is corrected.

23 C. The Corporation Commission shall promulgate rules as
24 necessary to implement the provisions of this section.

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SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2010.
