6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to elections; amending 26 O.S. 2001,
8 Section 5-105a, which relates to the Election Code;
9 modifying eligibility for candidacy; and providing an
10 effective date.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 26 O.S. 2001, Section 5-105a, is
13 amended to read as follows:

14 Section 5-105a. A. A person who has been convicted of a
15 misdemeanor involving embezzlement or a felony under the laws of
16 this state or of the United States or who has entered a plea of
17 guilty or nolo contendere to such misdemeanor involving embezzlement
18 or felony or who has been convicted of a crime in another state
19 which would have been a misdemeanor involving embezzlement or a
20 felony under the laws of this state or has entered a plea of guilty
21 or nolo contendere to such crime shall not be eligible to be a
22 candidate for or to be elected to any state, county, municipal,
23 judicial or school office or any other elective office of any
24 political subdivision of this state for a period of fifteen (15)

1 years following completion of his sentence or during the pendency of
2 an appeal of such conviction or plea.

3 B. The provisions of this section shall not be construed to
4 preclude a person who has received a pardon from being eligible for
5 or from holding public office.

6 C. A person who is listed as owing a fine to the Ethics
7 Commission on the Oklahoma Ethics Commission website shall not be
8 eligible to be a candidate for or to be elected to any state,
9 county, municipal, judicial or school office or any other elective
10 office of any political subdivision until the fine is paid in full.

11 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2010.
